1. Welcome

The Chairperson opened the meeting and welcomed all present. He allowed for brief introductions. He also reminded all of the protocol guiding virtual committee meetings.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the meeting was to interview two more candidates for the Western Cape Liquor Authority Government Board, and to submit recommendations to the Minister of Police Oversight and Community Safety. The Department of Police Oversight and Community Safety also briefed the Committee on the Policing Needs and Priorities for 2023/24.

3. The Committee proceeded to hold the remaining two for positions to the Western Cape Liquor Authority Governing Board. During each interview, each Committee Member posed a question. The Committee also posed follow up questions, specifically for clarity, where applicable.
4. The Chairperson used Rule 72(1) to close the broadcast of the meeting in order to deliberate on the scoring per candidate.

5. Recommendations

Following deliberations on the interviews, the Committee recommended that the Minister of Police Oversight and Community Safety, considers eight candidates, in order of preference, be considered for appointment. Please see Annexure B, the adopted report.

The meeting was suspended until 09:00. The Committee reconvened in an open meeting, as Rule 72 no longer applied to the business of the day.

6. The Chairperson welcomed Minister R Allen and his team of officials from the Department of Police Oversight and Community Safety.
7. The Department presented its PNP Report.
8. Following the discussion, the Chairperson thanked the Minister and the Department, and duly excused them from the meeting.
9. The Committee resolved to consider and adopt the draft PNP Report.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:13.

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Committee Report

Report of the Standing Committee on Police Oversight, Community Safety, and Cultural Affairs and Sport on the recommendations for the appointment of candidates to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority, dated 23 February 2024, as follows:

1. The Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority (the Board) required membership for six vacancies, in order to comply with Section 3(1) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008).
2. Section 3(3) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008) stipulates that “the standing committee must make the recommendations referred to in subsection(1) after evaluating all candidates as to their suitability for appointment”.
3. The Committee, having received a list of candidates from the Minister of Police Oversight and Community Safety in the Western Cape, proceeded to interview all 11 candidates between 22 and 23 February 2024.
4. The Committee resolved to submit the following candidates, in order of preference, for the appointment to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority to the Minister of Police Oversight and Community Safety.
