| Key item Descriptions | |

| Item Description | Short description |
| Constituency | A specified area which the Member is assigned by their Party, for which the Member is responsible for representing. |
| Accommodation | WCPP reimbursively covers Members Accommodation/Hotel costs if a Member travels officially |
| Accommodation-2nd Dwelling | This is a monthly contribution towards the actual housing or accommodation cost incurred where a primary residence is not within 50 kilometres from the seat of office. |
| Domestic Daily Allowance | If an employee must take an official journey within the borders of SA that lasts for 24 hours or longer, she/he may claim a fixed daily allowance . |
| Foreign Daily Allowance | If an employee must take an official journey outside the borders of SA that lasts for 24 hours or longer, she/he may claim a foreign predetermined daily allowance. |
| Entertainment- ito Presiding Officers Manual | Receptions and functions hosted, and reasonable entertainment expenses for official purposes and in the course of official duties (Excl. alcoholic beverages) |
| Airtickets- Members | If a Member must take an official journey , WCPP shall cover reasonable actual air travel costs |
| Study assistance | Payments made to institutions to provide direct support to employees for studying at universities or other tertiary institutions. |
| Accommodation-Domestic | If an employee must take an official journey within the borders of SA, the employer covers reasonable actual accommodation costs |
| Cellphone and Data/Wifi allowance | Cellphone and Data/Wifi costs paid to qualifying staff as per the Cellphone and Data policy. |
| Entertainment Allowance- Staff | Refreshments for team meetings reimbursed to Managers as per the Entertainment policy. |
| Reimbursive kms | If an employee must use private transport to carry out his/her duties, the employer may: i) provide an allowance to cover reasonable actual costs, and/or compensate the employee according to tariffs prescribed. |
| Incidental costs& transport | Incidental Costs = telephone cost, toll fees, parking fees, making of photocopies when on an official trip. Transport Costs = a motor vehicle is obtained from a private rental firm together with a driver. Example is a chauffeur driven vehicle. |
