1. Welcome and attendance

The Chairperson welcomed the Minister of Mobility, officials from the Western Cape Mobility Department, members of the Committee and members of the public to the deliberations on the 2024/25 Annual Reports of the Western Cape Mobility Department (the Department) and its Entity; Government Motor Transport (GMT). Members, the Minister and the officials introduced themselves for the record. The Chairperson noted the apology from Member B Herron (GOOD).

2. Deliberations on the 2024/25 Annual Report of the Western Cape Mobility Department

The Minister and the Head of the Department made opening remarks on the 2024/25 Annual Report of the Department. The Committee deliberated on Part A: General information, Part B: Performance Information and Part D: Human Resource Management of the Annual Report.

3. Deliberations on the 2024/25 Annual Report of Government Motor Transport

The Minister and the Head of the Department made opening remarks on the 2024/25 Annual Report of GMT. The Committee deliberated on Part A: General information, Part B: Performance Information and Part D: Human Resource Management of the Annual Report.

4. Public Participation

Mr Jamie Wyngaard from the mobility technology company, LOOP, addressed the Committee on tech-related solutions for some of the cash-related challenges experienced in the Minibus Taxi industry. He wanted to know how the public and private sectors could work with the Department to co-create solutions to some of the challenges experienced in the public transport sector.

The Minister indicated his commitment to engaging with LOOP on the matters raised by Mr Wyngaard.

5. Consideration and adoption of the Draft Committee Minutes

The Chairperson submitted the Draft Committee Minutes of 1 October 2025 for consideration by the Committee. The minutes were adopted without amendments.

6.1 The Committee, after its deliberations, REQUESTED the following:


- 6.1.1 A report on the number of interns absorbed into the Western Cape Mobility Department for the past two financial years;
- 6.1.2 A report on the average time officials spent in their respective positions before resigning or leaving the Western Cape Mobility Department (for resignations that occurred over the last two financial years);
- 6.1.3 A list of consultants used by the Western Cape Mobility Department and their Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment rating;
- 6.1.4 An updated schedule on the Western Cape Mobility Department's organisational redesign and recruitment plans;
- 6.1.5 A report on the Western Cape Mobility Department's review of transfer payments to municipalities;
- 6.1.6 A report from the Western Cape Mobility Department on its state of readiness to implement new laws and regulations on carbon tax;
- 6.1.7 A report on the nature of the gifts received by officials, who the gifts came from, and the recipients of the gifts within the Western Cape Mobility Department; and
- 6.1.8 A report from the Western Cape Mobility Department on the work done in respect of its intertown transport services, the expectations for this service and when the process is likely to begin.

6.2. The Committee REQUESTED that Government Motor Transport provides it with a report on the possibility of a partnership between the Western Cape Provincial Parliament and Government Motor Transport for the hiring of vehicles for Members of Provincial Parliament.

6.3 The Committee RECOMMENDED that Government Motor Transport explores the possibility of working more closely with municipalities, particularly around fleet management and the hiring of vehicles and equipment to deter wasteful expenditure.

6.4 The Committee RESOLVED that the Western Cape Mobility Department should brief the Committee on its organisational redesign, at a date to be determined by the Committee.
