### **1. Welcome**

The Chairperson opened the meeting and welcomed the Committee Members, the Minister of Mobility, officials from the Western Cape Mobility Department, stakeholders from the e-hailing industry and the members of the public.

The Chairperson noted the Rules of Engagement for members and officials that were attending virtually and proceeded to the presentations.

## **2. Briefing by the Western Cape E-hailing Association (WCEA)**

The Chairperson and Head of Business Development at WCEA briefed the Committee on the readiness of the e-hailing and metered taxi industry to implement the new laws under the National Land Transport Amendment Act (Act 23 of 2023) (NLTA Act), the safety of using e0hailing and metered taxis, and the support received from the Western Cape Government (WCG).

Once the presentation concluded, the Committee moved on to the second presentation.

## **3. Briefing by eCabs**

The Chairperson and the Secretary-General at eCabs briefed the Committee on the readiness of the e-hailing and metered taxi industry to implement the new laws under the National Land Transport Amendment Act (Act 23 of 2023) (NLTA Act), the safety of using e0hailing and metered taxis, and the support received from the Western Cape Government (WCG).

Once the presentation concluded, the Committee moved on to the last presentation.

## **4. Briefing by the Western Cape Mobility Department (WCMD)**

The Minister and WCMD officials briefed the Committee on the current state of vehicle operating licences in the Western Cape, and the extent of illegal mobility-related operations in the Western Cape.

Once the presentation concluded, the Committee held a question-and-answer session on all three presentations.

## **5. Consideration and adoption of the Draft Committee Documents**

The Chairperson submitted the Draft Committee Report on the 2024/25 Annual Reports of the WCMD and its Entity; the Government Motor Transport, which was considered and adopted without amendments.

The Chairperson submitted the Draft Committee Minutes of 24 October 2025, which was considered and adopted without amendments.

## **6. Resolutions/Actions**


6.1 The Committee REQUESTED the following from the Western Cape Mobility Department:

- 6.1.1 The memorandum that was submitted by the Western Cape E-hailing Association to the Minister of Mobility and the responses thereto;
- 6.1.2 A report on the progress of the Integrated Transport Plans and the extent to which municipalities were achieving their objectives; and
- 6.1.3 A report updating the Committee on the Demand Plans for the municipalities, and whether these plans were up-to-date and responding to real demand in their respective areas.

6.2 The Committee RECOMMENDED that the Western Cape Mobility Department monitors, assists and encourages the uptake of e-hailing services and operating licences in the different municipalities across the Western Cape.

6.3 The Committee FURTHER RECOMMENDED that the Minister of Mobility and the Western Cape Mobility Department consider the regulation that spoke to implementing name tags and branding on vehicles, as some drivers had safety concerns around this particular regulation.
