1. Welcome and apologies

The Chairperson welcomed the members, Minister, officials from the Provincial Treasury, Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board and any members of the public that were participating online. The Chairperson highlighted that the purpose of the meeting and noted that there were no apologies.

2. Briefing by the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board

The Minister and the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board (the Board) briefed the Committee on its spending trends, the spending trends of licence holders in respect of Corporate Social Investment, the number of complaints received and cases made against gambling establishments in the Western Cape, the turnaround times for resolving these complaints, and the steps taken to resolve the complaints.

The Committee engaged in a question-and-answer session on the information that was presented.

3. Consideration and adoption of the draft Committee documents

The Committee considered and adopted the draft Committee Minutes of 17 February 2026 without any amendments.


4. Resolutions/Actions

4.1 The Committee REQUESTED the following information from the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board:

- 4.1.1 A report on the regulatory and legislative frameworks that the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board would use in their assessment of licensees regarding their contribution to communities through Corporate Social Investment;
- 4.1.2 Any studies within the gambling industry which spoke to and quantified the impact of gambling harms (such as irresponsible gambling) versus the impact of Corporate Social Investment in communities;
- 4.1.3 A report on the extent to which the gambling industry was working on “self-regulation” i.e. an internal form of discipline that they have formulated to deal with harms created by gambling;
- 4.1.4 A list of beneficiaries who benefited from Corporate Social Investment for the 2025/26 financial year and the amounts each beneficiary received; and
- 4.1.5 A report on the work being done to promote responsible gambling, and the efforts made to counter gambling harms and issue warnings to individuals participating in gambling.

4.2 The Committee REQUESTED from the Provincial Treasury a report on alternative or additional revenue streams that could be generated directly by the government to ease reliance on revenue collected from gambling.
