1. Welcome and apologies

The Chairperson welcomed the members, officials from the Western Cape Mobility Department and any members of the public that were participating online. The Chairperson highlighted the purpose of the meeting and noted an apology from the Minister, Mr I Sileku, and the Acting Head of Department, Ms H Fakira.

2. Briefing by the Western Cape Mobility Department on their 2025/26 Third Quarterly Performance Report

The Western Cape Mobility Department (Department) briefed the Committee on their 2025/26 Third Quarterly Performance Report.

The Committee noted that although the Department was requested to present on the financial and non-financial performance, the Department only presented on the non-financial performance.

The Committee engaged in a question-and-answer session on the information that was presented.

3. Consideration and adoption of the draft Committee documents

The Committee considered and adopted the draft Committee Minutes of 19 February 2026, without amendments.

5. Resolutions/Actions

5.1 The Committee REQUESTED the following from the Western Cape Mobility Department:

- 5.1.1 A report on scholar transport breaking down (i) whether there is a database of scholar transport in the Western Cape (ii) whether there are unregistered scholar transport operators in the province (iii) the number of scholar transport operators in the Western Cape for the past financial year and the number of scholar transport operators in rural areas (iv) the number of compliant and non-compliant scholar transport operators (iii) the process for approval of scholar transport operations and how the Department assesses for compliance and approval (v) the conditions to become a compliant scholar transport operator, and (vi) what the Department is doing to address non-compliant scholar transport operators so they can become compliant;
 - 5.1.2 A report on the financial information for the Department's 2025/26 Third Quarterly Financial Performance, which was not presented to the Committee;
 - 5.1.3 A report updating the Committee on the information provided in January 2026 on the number of Motor Vehicle Licenses issued in the Western Cape for the past five years, which should include updated information until the end of the financial year (January to end of March 2026), including (i) the number of vehicle licenses at 1 January 2026 (ii) the number of licenses added between January and the end of March 2026 (iii) the number of vehicles removed from the system during this period (iv) the closing balances in respect of vehicle licenses at the end of March 2026, and (v) the percentage of fees collected by municipalities during this time; and
 - 5.1.4 A report updating the Committee on the status and perceived timelines for the roll out of the George Integrated Public Transport Network to Uniondale.
- 5.2 The Committee RESOLVED that the Standing Committee on Mobility and the Standing Committee on Police Oversight, Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport should hold a joint meeting on the current taxi tensions, if there is time to do so.
