1. Welcome and apologies

The Chairperson welcomed the members, Minister, officials from the Provincial Treasury, Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board and any members of the public that were participating online. The Chairperson highlighted that the purpose of the meeting was to deliberate on Vote 3: Provincial Treasury, in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 1-2026]. The Chairperson noted that there were no apologies submitted for this meeting.

2. Deliberations on Vote 3: Provincial Treasury, in the Schedule for the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 1-2026]

The Committee deliberated on the subject of the appropriation for Vote 3: Provincial Treasury, in the Western Cape 2026 Estimates of Provincial Revenue and Expenditure book.

The Committee continued to the expression on the Vote.

3. Consideration and adoption of the Report on Vote 3: Provincial Treasury, in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 1-2026]

The Chairperson requested that members express their views on the Vote. The Committee expressed its view that it supported the Vote, and the African National Congress and Al Jama-ah expressed their Minority View to not support the Vote.

Member Petrus indicated that while the Patriotic Alliance supported the Vote, they had reservations that the budget was not reflective of the inclusion and integration of small businesses and the role they played in the economy.

The Committee considered and adopted the Report.

4. Consideration and adoption of the draft Committee documents

The following documents were considered and adopted without amendments:



- 5.2 The guidelines and tools utilised by municipalities to determine cost-reflective tariffs;
- 5.3 The list of clauses within the Public Procurement Act, 2024 (Act 28 of 2024), which the Provincial Treasury identified as problematic; and
- 5.4 A report providing an update on the three municipalities under Financial Recovery Plans, including whether these municipalities have improved their situations, which phase of recovery they were in, and timelines for when they will be graduating from their respective Financial Recovery Plans.
