SUBJECT FOR DISCUSSION

Mr D W Bryant: The impact of the recent severe flooding on infrastructure, agriculture, energy systems and vulnerable communities in the Western Cape, and the measures required to improve disaster preparedness, recovery coordination and long-term climate resilience.

FURTHER BUSINESS

NOTICES OF MOTION (4 June 2026)

1. Mr N D Nkondlo: The devastating impact of the recent storms in the Western Cape that has triggered a severe electricity crisis threatening the province's agricultural economy, fruit exports and thousands of jobs.
2. Mr M B Ngqentsu: The alarming increase and ongoing spate of mass shootings across communities in the Western Cape.
3. Ms P Z Lekker: The continued failures of the City of Cape Town's sewage and storm-water drainage systems, and the devastating impact that these failures have on poor and working-class communities, including recurring flooding, exposure to raw sewage, health hazards, environmental degradation, damage to homes and property, and the indignity faced by residents living in unsafe and inhumane conditions.
4. Ms P Z Lekker: The deepening housing crisis in the Western Cape where more than 440 000 people remain on the housing waiting list while thousands of families continue to live in informal settlements, in overcrowded conditions and in backyard dwellings.

NOTICES OF MOTION (21 May 2026)

1. Ms R Windvogel: That the House notes the Western Cape Government's announcement of the planned appointment of more than 800 additional healthcare personnel, including 316 nurses and 124 doctors, as part of the 2026/27 Health and Wellness budget aimed at strengthening healthcare service delivery across the province; further notes that this announcement comes against the backdrop of an ongoing and deepening crisis in the public healthcare system, characterised by chronic staff shortages, increasing patient backlogs, overcrowded facilities, long waiting times, overstretched emergency services and the deteriorating infrastructure in many public health institutions; acknowledges that, while the appointment of additional healthcare professionals represents a necessary and positive step, it is not sufficient on its own to resolve the structural challenges facing the healthcare system, particularly in working-class communities, rural towns, informal settlements and historically disadvantaged areas where access to consistent and quality healthcare remains uneven and inadequate; further notes with concern that many residents continue to experience delayed access to medical treatment, medicine stock shortages, postponed surgeries and under-resourced clinics, with vulnerable groups, such as the elderly, women, children and persons living with chronic illnesses, disproportionately affected by the strain on the system; recognises and commends the dedication, resilience and sacrifice of nurses, doctors, emergency medical personnel, community healthcare workers and support staff who continue to deliver services under extremely demanding conditions despite systemic constraints; expresses concern that persistent challenges in healthcare planning, infrastructure investment, staffing retention and resource allocation continue to undermine the ability of the public healthcare system to meet the growing demand for services; further notes that repeated concerns raised by healthcare professionals, labour organisations and affected communities regarding staffing levels, working conditions and infrastructure backlogs have not been adequately addressed in a sustainable and comprehensive manner; and therefore calls on the provincial government to present urgently to this House a clear, detailed and transparent implementation plan outlining the deployment of the newly appointed healthcare personnel, measures to ensure equitable allocation to rural and underserved areas, strategies to improve retention of healthcare workers in the public sector, and a long-term plan to strengthen infrastructure, reduce patient backlogs and ensure the delivery of accessible, equitable and quality healthcare services for all residents of the Western Cape.
2. Mr M B Ngqentsu: That the House notes the recent taxi fare increases implemented across the province from 18 May 2026; further notes with grave concern that these increases place an unbearable financial burden on poor and working-class households that rely on minibus taxis as their primary mode of transport and who are now expected to pay between R2 and R5 more for daily trips to schools, healthcare facilities and other essential services; acknowledges that many commuters in townships, squatter camps and rural communities are already struggling to survive under the weight of rising food prices, electricity costs, unemployment and the broader cost-of-living crisis; recognises that transport costs consume a significant portion of household income for low-income families, forcing many residents to choose between paying for transport, buying food or meeting other basic needs; expresses concern that the absence of meaningful government intervention continues to leave vulnerable commuters exposed to escalating transport costs while public transport alternatives remain unreliable and inaccessible for many communities; and therefore calls on the provincial government and the national government to introduce and expand public

transport subsidies for taxi commuters urgently, to engage with the taxi industry on sustainable relief measures, and to prioritise policies that protect poor and working-class residents from the devastating socio-economic impact of rising taxi fares.

3. Mr M B Ngqentsu: That the House notes with deep concern the revelation that 837 rape cases in the Western Cape were closed between 2022 and 2025 due to victims allegedly being classified as “untraceable”; further notes that these alarming statistics reflect serious shortcomings in the criminal justice system, particularly in the investigation and prosecution of gender-based violence and sexual offences; acknowledges that survivors of rape often endure severe trauma, fear, intimidation and social stigma when reporting these crimes, and that many victims from poor and working-class communities face additional barriers, such as unsafe living conditions, lack of transport, inadequate victim support services and economic vulnerability; recognises that the closure of these cases not only denies survivors justice but also emboldens perpetrators of gender-based violence, and further erodes public confidence in the South African Police Service and the broader justice system; expresses concern over ongoing reports of detective shortages, inadequate investigative capacity, poor follow-up procedures and failures in victim support mechanisms in the SAPS and related institutions; condemns the systemic failures that continue to leave women and children vulnerable at a time when gender-based violence and femicide remain at crisis levels across the country; and therefore calls on the provincial government, the SAPS leadership and the national Department of Police to strengthen victim tracing mechanisms urgently, to increase resources for Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences units, to improve survivor support services, to ensure accountability in the handling of rape cases, and to prioritise the effective investigation and prosecution of all gender-based violence offences.
4. Ms N D Nkondlo: That the House notes with deep concern the devastating losses suffered by farmers and agricultural communities across the Western Cape following the severe flooding and intense cold fronts that swept through the province; further notes that the floods caused widespread destruction to crops, vineyards, orchards, livestock, irrigation systems, roads, bridges and other critical farming infrastructure in key agricultural regions, including the Hex River Valley, Grabouw, Elgin, Ceres and Worcester; acknowledges that many farmers, farmworkers and rural communities are now facing immense economic uncertainty as agricultural production, food supply chains and export operations continue to be severely disrupted; recognises that the agricultural sector remains a vital contributor to employment, food security and economic activity in the Western Cape, particularly in rural areas where thousands of families depend directly on farming for their livelihoods; expresses concern that repeated climate-related disasters continue to expose the vulnerability of rural infrastructure, disaster preparedness systems and support mechanisms available to farmers and farming communities; further acknowledges the humanitarian impact of the floods on farmworkers and surrounding communities, many of whom have lost homes, belongings and access to essential services; and therefore calls on the provincial government to provide urgently disaster relief funding, infrastructure recovery support and financial assistance to affected farmers and farmworkers, to strengthen climate resilience measures in vulnerable agricultural areas, and to ensure that no farming community is left behind in the Province’s disaster recovery efforts.
5. Ms N D Nkondlo: That the House notes with serious concern the ongoing failure of the cable and telephone line infrastructure on the fourth floor of the Western Cape Provincial

Parliament Building, which has reportedly been dysfunctional for an extended period without resolution; further notes that the persistent breakdown of communication systems negatively affects the ability of Members and staff to effectively perform their constitutional and legislative duties, and undermines productivity, responsiveness and institutional efficiency in the legislature; acknowledges that, in a modern democratic institution, reliable communication infrastructure is not a luxury, but a basic operational necessity required to ensure seamless governance, coordination and public service delivery; expresses concern that the prolonged neglect of this matter reflects poorly on the administration and maintenance standards in the WCPP, particularly in a space meant to uphold accountability, professionalism and effective governance; and calls on the relevant parliamentary administration and technical support services to intervene urgently, to provide a full report on the cause of the failures, to outline why the issue has remained unresolved for such a prolonged period, and to ensure that the cable and telephone systems on the fourth floor are restored without any further delay.

6. Mr N P Masipa: That the House notes with deep concern the catastrophic impact of the intense frontal systems that have battered the Western Cape, leaving our agricultural heartlands in a state of emergency; notes that the record-shattering rainfall has caused the Breede River to burst its banks, causing widespread devastation from Rawsonville and Worcester down through the Langeberg and Swellendam municipalities, where orchards and vineyards were submerged; further notes the severe damage to farming infrastructure in Robertson and Swellendam, including the evacuation of communities, such as Silverstrand, and the destruction of vital access bridges, which has left both commercial and small-scale farmers unable to reach their livestock or crops; further notes the severe blow to the citrus industry, particularly in the Langkloof and Gamtoos valleys, where farmers report losing up to 70% of their crop in certain blocks, alongside the total destruction of vital irrigation systems, farm bridges and the undermining of key export arteries, such as the N1 corridor; acknowledges the harrowing humanitarian toll on our rural communities, including the emergency roof-top evacuations of farmworkers, and the tragic loss of life across the province, as well as the long-term threat to food security and the livelihoods of thousands of seasonal workers; and recognises the rapid response of the NSRI, provincial disaster management and the Department of Agriculture teams currently conducting damage assessments.

Mnr D W Bryant: Die impak van die onlangse ernstige oorstromings op infrastruktuur, landbou, energiestelsels en weerlose gemeenskappe in die Wes-Kaap, en die maatreëls wat vereis word om rampvoorbereiding, herstelkoördinerings en klimaatsveerkragtigheid op die lang termyn te verbeter.

VERDERE WERKSAAMHEDE

KENNISGEWING VAN VOORSTELLE (4 Junie 2026)

1. Mnr N D Nkondlo: Die verwoestende impak van die onlangse storms in die Wes-Kaap wat 'n ernstige elektrisiteitskrisis veroorsaak het wat die provinsie se landbou-ekonomie, vrugte-uitvoere en duisende werkgeleenthede bedreig.
2. Mnr M B Ngqentsu: Die kommerwekkende toename en voortdurende vlaag massaskiet-voorvalle in gemeenskappe in die Wes-Kaap.
3. Me P Z Lekker: Die voortdurende mislukkings van die Stad Kaapstad se riool- en stormwaterdreineringsstelsels, en die verwoestende impak wat hierdie mislukkings op arm en werkersklasgemeenskappe het, insluitende herhalende oorstromings, blootstelling aan rou riool, gesondheidsgevaare, omgewingsagteruitgang, skade aan huise en eiendom, en die vernedering wat inwoners verduur wat hulself in onveilige en onmenslike toestande bevind.
4. Me P Z Lekker: Die groter wordende behuisingskrisis in die Wes-Kaap waar meer as 440 000 mense op die waglys vir behuising bly terwyl duisende gesinne steeds in informele nedersettings, in oorbevolkte omstandighede en in agterplaaswonnings woon.

KENNISGEWING VAN VOORSTELLE (21 Mei 2026)

1. Me R Windvogel: Dat die Huis kennis neem van die Wes-Kaapse Regering se aankondiging van die beoogde aanstelling van meer as 800 bykomende gesondheidsorgpersoneel, insluitende 316 verpleegkundiges en 124 dokters, as deel van die 2026/27-begroting vir Gesondheid en Welstand wat ten doel het om dienslewering vir gesondheidsorg in die provinsie te versterk; verder kennis neem dat hierdie aankondiging gemaak is teen die agtergrond van 'n voortgesette en groter wordende krisis in die stelsel vir openbare gesondheidsorg, wat gekenmerk word deur chroniese personeeltekorte, toeneemende pasiëntagterstande, oorvol fasiliteite, lang wagtye, nooddienste wat onder groot druk verkeer en die verbrokkelende infrastruktuur by talle instellings vir openbare gesondheid; erkenning gee dat, alhoewel die aanstelling van bykomende gesondheidsorgberoepslui 'n noodsaaklike en positiewe stap is, dit alleen nie genoeg is om die strukturele uitdagings op te los wat die stelsel vir gesondheidsorg die hoof moet bied nie, veral in werkersklasgemeenskappe, plattelandse dorpe, informele nedersettings en voorheen benadeelde gebiede waar toegang tot volgehoue gesondheidsorg en gesondheidsorg van gehalte steeds ongelyk en onvoldoende is; verder met kommer kennis neem dat talle inwoners steeds vertraagde toegang tot mediese behandeling, tekorte aan medisynevoorraad, uitgestelde operasies en onderbefondsde klinieke ervaar, waar weerlose groepe, soos bejaardes, vroue, kinders en persone met chroniese siektes, op 'n ongelyke wyse deur die druk op die stelsel geraak word; erkenning gee aan en die toewyding, veerkragtigheid en opoffering van verpleegkundiges, dokters, mediese noodpersoneel, gemeenskaps-gesondheidswerkers en ondersteuningspersoneel loof wat in uiters veel-eisende omstandighede steeds dienste lewer ondanks sistemiese beperkings; kommer uitspreek omdat volgehoue uitdagings met gesondheidsorgbeplanning, infrastruktuurbelegging, personeelbehoud en hulprontoeuwysing steeds die vermoë van die stelsel vir openbare gesondheid ondermyn om in die toenemende aanvraag na dienste te voorsien; verder kennis neem dat herhaalde kommer geopper is deur gesondheidsorgberoepslui, arbeidsorganisasies en gemeenskappe wat geraak is, met betrekking tot personeelvoorsieningsvlakke, werkomstandighede en infrastruktuuragterstande omdat daar nie op 'n volhoubare en omvattende manier voldoende daaraan aandag geskenk is nie; en dus 'n beroep doen op die provinsiale regering om dringend aan hierdie Huis 'n gedetailleerde en deursigtige implementeringsplan voor te lê wat die ontplooiing van die nuut aangestelde gesondheidsorgpersoneel uiteensit, maatreëls om billike toewysing aan plattelandse en onderbediende gebiede te verseker, strategieë om die behoud van gesondheidsorgwerkers in die staatsdiens te verbeter, en 'n langtermynplan om infrastruktuur te versterk, pasiëntagterstande te verminder en om toe te sien dat toeganklike, billike en gehaltesdienste vir gesondheidsorg aan alle inwoners van die Wes-Kaap gelewer word.
2. Mnr M B Ngqentsu: Dat die Huis kennis neem van die onlangse stygings in taxifooie wat vanaf 18 Mei 2026 in die provinsie ingestel is; verder met diepe kommer kennis neem dat hierdie stygings 'n ondraaglike finansiële las op arm en werkersklasgemeenskappe plaas wat op minibustaxi's as hul primêre vervoermiddel staatmaak en van wie nou verwag word om tussen R2 en R5 meer vir daaglikse ritte na skole, fasiliteite vir gesondheidsorg en ander noodsaaklike dienste te betaal; erkenning gee dat talle pendelaars in townships, plakkerskampe en plattelandse gemeenskappe reeds sukkel om te oorleef met die druk van stygende voedselpryse, elektrisiteitskoste, werkloosheid en die groter lewenskostekrisis; erkenning gee dat vervoerkoste 'n beduidende deel van die huishoudingsinkomste van lae-inkomste-families verbruik, wat talle inwoners dwing om te kies of hulle vir vervoer moet

betaal, kos moet koop of na ander basiese behoeftes moet omsien; kommer uitspreek dat die gebrek aan betekenisvolle ingryping deur die staat weerlose inwoners steeds blootstel aan stygende vervoerkoste terwyl alternatiewe vir openbare vervoer steeds onbetroubaar en ontoeganklik vir talle gemeenskappe is; en dus 'n beroep doen op die provinsiale regering en die nasionale regering om dringend subsidies vir openbare vervoer vir taxipendelaars bekend te stel en uit te brei, om met die taxibedryf te skakel oor volhoubare verligtingsmaatreëls, en om beleide te prioritiseer wat arm en werkersklasinwoners teen die rampspoedige sosio-ekonomiese impak van stygende taxifooie beskerm.

3. Mnr M B Ngqentsu: Dat die Huis met diepe kommer kennis neem van die bekendmaking dat 837 verkragtingsake in die Wes-Kaap tussen 2022 en 2025 gesluit is as gevolg van slagoffers wat na bewering as “onopspoorbaar” geklassifiseer is; verder kennis neem dat hierdie kommerwekkende statistiek ernstige tekortkominge in die strafregstelsel weerspieël, veral met die ondersoek en vervolging van geslagsgebaseerde geweld en seksuele misdrywe; erkenning gee dat verkragting-slagoffers dikwels ernstige trauma, vrees, intimidasie en maatskaplike stigma verduur wanneer hulle hierdie misdade aanmeld, en dat talle slagoffers wat uit arm en werkersklasgemeenskappe kom, bykomende struikelblokke die hoof moet bied, soos onveilige lewensomstandighede, 'n gebrek aan vervoer, onvoldoende dienste vir slagofferondersteuning en ekonomiese weerloosheid; erkenning gee dat die sluiting van hierdie sake nie net slagoffers van geregtigheid ontnem nie, maar oortreders van geslagsgebaseerde geweld ook aanspoor, en openbare vertroue in die Suid-Afrikaanse Polisiediens (SAPD) en die groter regstelsel verder vernietig; kommer uitspreek oor voortgesette berigte van tekorte aan speurders, onvoldoende kapasiteit vir ondersoeke, swak opvolgprosedures en mislukkings van meganismes vir slagofferondersteuning in die SAPD en verwante instellings; verontwaardiging uitspreek oor die sistemiese versuime wat vroue en kinders steeds weerloos laat in 'n stadium waarin geslagsgebaseerde geweld en vrouemoord steeds op krisisvlakke in die land is; en dus 'n beroep doen op die provinsiale regering, die leierskap van die SAPD en die nasionale Departement van Polisie om meganismes vir die opsporing van slagoffers dringend te verbeter, om hulpbronne vir eenhede vir gesinsgeweld, kindermishandeling en seksuele oortredings te verhoog, om dienste vir slagofferondersteuning te verbeter, om toe te sien dat daar verantwoordingspligtigheid is vir die hantering van verkragtingsake, en om die doeltreffende ondersoek en vervolging van alle oortredings vir geslagsgebaseerde geweld te prioritiseer.
4. Me N Nkondlo: Dat die Huis met diepe kommer kennis neem van die rampspoedige verliese wat boere en landbougemeenskappe in die Wes-Kaap gely het ná die ernstige oorstromings en groot kouefronte wat die provinsie getref het; verder kennis neem dat die vloede wydverspreide verwoesting gesaai het aan gewasse, boorde, vee, besproeiingstelsels, paaie, brûe en ander kritieke boerdery-infrastruktuur in belangrike landboustreke, insluitende die Hexriviervallei, Grabouw, Elgin, Ceres en Worcester; erkenning gee dat talle boere, plaaswerkers en plattelandse gemeenskappe nou ontsaglike ekonomiese onsekerheid die hoof moet bied aangesien landbouproduksie, voedselvoorsieningskanale en uitvoerbedrywigheede steeds ernstig ontwrig is; erkenning gee dat die landbousektor steeds 'n uiters noodsaaklike bydraer tot indiensneming, voedselsekerheid en ekonomiese aktiwiteit in die Wes-Kaap is, veral in plattelandse gebiede waar duisende families direk van boerdery afhanklik is vir hul lewensbestaan; kommer uitspreek dat herhaalde klimaatsverwante rampe voortgaan om die weerloosheid van plattelandse infrastruktuur, stelsels vir

rampgereedheid en ondersteuningsmeganismes blootlê wat aan boere en plaasgemeenskappe beskikbaar is; verder erkenning gee aan die humanitêre impak van die vloede op plaaswerkers en omliggende gemeenskappe, waarvan talle hul huise, besittings en toegang tot noodsaaklike dienste verloor het; en dus 'n beroep op die provinsiale regering doen om dringend befondsing vir rampverligting, ondersteuning vir infrastruktuurherstel en finansiële bystand te verskaf aan boere en plaaswerkers wat geraak is, om maatreëls vir klimaatsveerkragtigheid in kwesbare landbougebiede te versterk, en om toe te sien dat geen plaasgemeenskap agterweë gelaat word in die Provinsie se pogings vir rampherstel nie.

5. Me N D Nkondlo: Dat die Huis met diepe kommer kennis neem dat die kabel- en telefoonlyninfrastruktuur op die vierde vloer van die Wes-Kaapse Provinsiale Parlement-gebou gedurig ophou werk, wat volgens berigte 'n geruime tyd al sonder 'n oplossing buite werking is; verder kennis neem dat die volgehoue onderbreking van kommunikasiestelsels Lede en personeellede se vermoë om hul grondwetlike en wetlike pligte doeltreffend uit te voer, negatief beïnvloed en produktiwiteit, responsiwiteit en institusionele doeltreffendheid by die wetgewer ondermyn; erkenning gee dat, by 'n moderne demokratiese instelling, betroubare infrastruktuur vir kommunikasie nie 'n luuksheid is nie, maar 'n basiese bedryfsnoodsaaklikheid is wat nodig is om gladde bestuurstoedig, koördinerende en die lewering van openbare dienste te verseker; kommer uitspreek dat die verlengde nalating van hierdie aangeleentheid 'n swak weerspieëling van die administrasie en standarde vir instandhouding by die WKPP is, veral by 'n instelling wat verantwoordingspligtigheid, professionaliteit en doeltreffende bestuurstoedig moet handhaaf; en 'n beroep doen op die toepaslike administrasiediens en die diens vir tegniese ondersteuning om dringend in te gryp, om 'n volledige verslag oor die oorsaak van die faling te verskaf, om uiteen te sit waarom die kwessie vir so 'n lang tydperk nie opgelos is nie, en om toe te sien dat die kabel- en telefoonstelsels op die vierde vloer sonder enige verdere vertraging herstel word.
6. Me B Stoffel: Dat die Huis met diepe kommer kennis neem van berigte dat die Stad Kaapstad inwoners in werkersklasgemeenskappe, veral in Hanover Park, met boetes van tot R800 000 en moontlike tronkstraf gedreig het omdat hulle klein- informele sakeondernemings uit hul wonings bedryf; verder kennis neem dat talle van hierdie inwoners pensionarisse, werklose mense en sukkelende families is wat op die verkoop van gebakte goedere, lekkers, vetkoek, koesisters en ander klein items staatmaak net om te oorleef te midde van armoede wat vererger, werkloosheid en die stygende lewenskoste; erkenning gee dat Suid-Afrika se informele ekonomie steeds 'n kritieke bron van inkomste en waardigheid vir miljoene arm en werkersklashuishoudings is wat steeds in die steek gelaat word deur 'n ekonomie wat nie genoeg werkgeleenthede skep nie; verontwaardiging uitspreek dat, terwyl gemeenskappe op die Kaapse Vlakte steeds deur bendebedrywighede, dwelms, afpersing, werkloosheid, behuisingsagterstande en verbrokkelende maatskaplike omstandighede geteister word, dit lyk asof die Stad meer fokus op die kriminalisering van arm inwoners wat probeer om kos op die tafel te sit; verder kommer uitspreek dat die aggressiewe toepassing van verordeninge teen weerlose inwoners die teen-armoede- en onsensitiewe karakter blootlê van bestuurstoedig wat strafoptrede bo betekenisvolle ekonomiese ondersteuning en gemeenskapsontwikkeling plaas; en 'n beroep op die Stad Kaapstad doen om dadelik alle intimidasie en strafmaatreëls te staak teen inwoners wat geraak word, om te goeder trou met gemeenskappe te skakel en om 'n welwillende, ontwikkelings- en armgesinde benadering te ontwikkel wat informele handelaars en tuisgebaseerde entrepreneurs wat sukkel om te oorleef, ondersteun eerder as straf.
