- 5.1.3 To send the Western Cape Provincial Parliament's (WCPP) Research Unit's report on Certification Courses and Agriculture Technology and Innovative Farming to the Department of Agriculture for consideration in terms of innovative employability in the agricultural sector; and
- 5.1.4 To send the WCPP's Research Unit's report on Skills Development for Unemployed Youth to the Department of Economic Development and Tourism to consider the successful case studies from other countries.
- 5.2 The Committee further REQUESTED that the WCPP's Research Unit provide the following information on the Harambee Youth Employment Accelerator Programme:
 - 5.2.1 How much funding the Programme received when it was funded by the Job's Fund, as it was important to ascertain what value the government received for the money it spent on the Programme; and
 - 5.2.2 How many individuals actually participated in the Programme, and how many of the participants resided in the Western Cape.
