- (1) (a) How many families have been evicted from (i) Woodstock and (ii) Salt River since 2009 and (b) for each, what were the reasons for the eviction;
- (2) whether there are any planned future evictions; if so, what are the relevant details?

2. Mr P Uys to ask Mr B S Madikizela, Minister of Human Settlements:

- (1) How many bucket toilet systems have been in use for each year from 2014 to date;
- (2) whether any progress has been made in the eradicating the bucket toilet system in formal and informal areas in the province; if not, (a) why not and (b) when will it be eradicated; if so; what are the relevant details?

- (a) What is the total number of sports facilities in the municipal area of Mossel Bay, (b) what do these facilities consist of, (c) where are they located and (d) which of these facilities are accessible to the public free of charge?

Whether his Department and each entity reporting to him appointed transaction advisers for tenders in the period 2014 to date; if so, (a) who were the transaction advisers who were appointed for the tenders, (b) for which tenders were they appointed, (c) what was the pricing for the tenders in question and (d) what amount were the transaction advisers paid?

- (1) What has been the monthly water bill for the (a) Mitchells Plain Hospital, (b) Lentegeur Hospital and (c) Tafelsig Clinic in the 2016/17 financial year;
- (2) whether these health facilities implemented any measures to reduce water consumption; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) what systems are these health facilities using for their laundry;
- (4) whether the laundry systems are efficiently saving water; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (5) whether the facilities considered alternative systems for their laundry in order to reduce water consumption; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?
