The Chairperson opened the meeting by welcoming the members of the Committee and the Departmental officials.

2. Briefing by the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning on progress in respect of the Berg River Improvement Plan

The Department provided the Committee with background information on water supply planning and water risk by outlining the contributing factors and impact of the current drought in the Province. The Department further informed the Committee of the cooperative approach that it employs within all spheres of Government and the public to ensure that water is well-managed to safeguard its long-term sustainability while providing growth and development in the Province.

To this end the Department provided a comprehensive overview of the Sustainable Water Management Plan, the Berg River Improvement Plan and the Breede River Environmental Resources Protection Plan.

3. Resolutions/Actions

- 3.1 The Committee REQUESTED that the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning provides it with:
- 3.1.1 The cost and timelines for the implementation of the Genius of Systems for People's Access to a Clean Environment Project in informal settlements; and
- 3.1.2 A list of the 21 Municipalities that have been determined as high risk in terms of water scarcity after the compilation of the respective Disaster Management and Risk Assessment Registers for each municipality.
- 3.2 The Committee RESOLVED to, at a future date, request the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning to brief it on the rehabilitation of wetland areas in order to improve the ecological conditions thereof, including that of water retention and infiltration within catchment areas.
