COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. **The Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport having considered a shortlist of nominees for appointment to the Western Cape Cultural Commission on 12 November 2021, reports as follows:**
 1. In terms of section 4(2)(a) of the Western Cape Cultural Commission and Cultural Councils Act, 1998 (Act 14 of 1998), the Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport invited “the general public to nominate persons as members of the Cultural Commission”.
 2. The Committee first set a deadline of 3 August 2021 and thereafter extended the deadline to 10 September 2021. This was to ensure a wider range of nominations.
 3. In order to comply with section 4(2)(b) of the Western Cape Cultural Commission and Cultural Councils Act, 1998 (Act 14 of 1998), the Committee resolved to submit its shortlist of candidates to the Provincial Minister of Cultural Affairs and Sport for consideration for appointment.

2. **The Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport, having considered a shortlist of nominees for appointment to the Western Cape Provincial Language Committee on 12 November 2021, reports as follows:**
 1. In terms of section 7(2)(a) of the Western Cape Provincial Languages Act, 1998 (Act 13 of 1998), the Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport invited “the general public to nominate persons as members of the Language Committee”.
 2. The Committee first set a deadline of 3 August 2021 and thereafter extended the deadline to 10 September 2021. This was to ensure a wider range of nominations.

3. In order to comply with section 7(2)(b) of the Western Cape Languages Act, 1998 (Act 13 of 1998), the Committee resolved to submit its shortlist of candidates to the Provincial Minister of Cultural Affairs and Sport for consideration for appointment.

3. Report of the Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport on recommendations for the appointment of candidates to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority, dated 12 November 2021, as follows:

1. The Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority (the Board) required membership for two vacancies in order to comply with section 3(1)(a) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008).
2. Section 3(3) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008), stipulates that “the standing committee must make the recommendations referred to in subsection (1) after evaluating all candidates as to their suitability for appointment”.
3. The Committee, having received a list of candidates from the Minister of Community Safety in the Western Cape, proceeded to interview all of the five eligible candidates on 12 November 2021.
4. The Committee resolved to submit its recommendations for appointments to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority to the Provincial Minister of Community Safety.
