COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. **Report of the Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport on the recommendations for the appointment of a candidate to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority, dated 4 March 2022, as follows:**
 1. The Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority (the Board) required membership for a vacancy in order to comply with section 3(1)(a) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008).
 2. Section 3(3) of the Western Cape Liquor Act, 2008 (Act 4 of 2008), stipulates that “the standing committee must make the recommendations referred to in subsection(1) after evaluating all candidates as to their suitability for appointment”.

3. The Committee, having received a list of candidates from the Minister of Community Safety in the Western Cape, proceeded to interview eight of the nine eligible candidates on 4 March 2022. One candidate withdrew from the interview process.
 4. The Committee resolved to submit its recommendations for the appointment to the Governing Board of the Western Cape Liquor Authority to the Provincial Minister of Community Safety.
2. **The Standing Committee on Community Safety, Cultural Affairs and Sport having deliberated on the 2020/21 Policing Needs and Priorities Report, dated 3 March 2022, reports as follows:**
1. The Committee, having received the referral of the Policing Needs and Priorities 2020/21 Report, in terms of section 23(2) of the Western Cape Community Safety Act, 2013 (Act 3 of 2013), proceeded to discuss the Report.
 2. The Committee, in terms of section 23(3) of the Act, considered the Report.
 3. The Committee, in terms of section 23(4) of the Act, afforded the Provincial Police Commissioner of the South African Police Service (SAPS) and the Executive Head of Municipal Policing the opportunity to give input on the Report.
 4. The Committee, having considered the input given by the Provincial Police Commissioner of the South African Police Service (SAPS) and the Executive Head of Municipal Policing, reports that it has concluded its deliberations on the Report and has no further recommendations.
