**COMMITTEE REPORT**

*(Negotiating mandate stage)* Report of the Budget Committee on the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B 24–2017] (S76) (NCOP), dated 16 November 2017, as follows:

The Budget Committee, having considered the subject of the Division of Revenue Amendment Bill [B 24–2017] (S76) (NCOP) referred to the Committee in accordance with Standing Rule 220, confers on the Western Cape’s delegation in the NCOP the authority not to support the Amendment Bill for the following reasons:

1. The national government did not place strong focus on the:
  - 1.1 Division of Revenue Bill and the equitable share;
  - 1.2 fiscal consolidation; and
  - 1.3 underperforming state-owned enterprises or entities.
2. The national government should further consider to:
  - 2.1 act strongly against corruption; and
  - 2.2 support the application from the Western Cape relating to the drought that has an impact on agriculture, economic growth and employment.
