- (1) Whether her Department can provide details on the reported absorption of 400 community health workers into her Department; if not, why not; if so, (a) how many have already been absorbed, (b) how many are still to be absorbed and (c) what is the expected time frame for the completion of this process;
- (2) whether her Department has identified the specific hospitals, clinics or healthcare facilities where these community health workers will be deployed; if not, why not; if so, (a) which facilities have been identified and (b) what criteria were used to determine their placement?

With regard to the deployment of 800 troops on the Cape Flats:

Whether the allocation of R23,9 million for rural development will be sufficient to address the challenges of rural poverty, support for farmworkers and youth inclusion in rural communities; if not, why not; if so, (a) what specific programmes will be funded through this allocation, (b) how many beneficiaries are expected to be reached and (c) what measurable outcomes are anticipated?

There is a 11,97% increase in the Compensation of Employees (CoE) in the 2026/27 budget:

(a) How many vacant posts are (i) funded but remain unfilled and (ii) have been advertised and (b) what measures is his Department implementing to fill these vacancies urgently in order to prevent further service delivery failures?

With reference to a housing transfer (erf 318, Delft, City of Cape Town) that took place in 2013 between the Western Cape Government and a certain person whose name has been furnished to his Department for the purpose of his reply:

(1) Whether his Department can confirm that a subsidised housing unit allocated to the original beneficiary, whose name has been furnished to his Department for the purpose of his reply, was transferred to another beneficiary in 2013 while the original beneficiary was still alive and a qualifying beneficiary; if so, (a) on what basis was

the transfer approved and (b) what processes were followed to verify the occupancy and beneficiary status prior to the transfer;

- (2) whether the original beneficiary was informed of or consented to the transfer prior to its approval; if not, why not; if so, on what date was such notification given;
- (3) whether the transfer was registered in the Deeds Office; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (4) whether his Department was aware that the original beneficiary claimed to be the beneficiary of the subsidised house until his passing away in 2017; if so, (a) what steps were taken to engage the heirs and (b) what is the status of the heirs' claim to the subsidised house;
- (5) whether the Department intends to review the 2013 transfer; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (6) how many other disputed transfers is his Department currently (a) aware of or (b) dealing with?

**10. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr A R Winde, Premier:**

On 28 April 2019 the Western Cape Government announced a formal intergovernmental dispute with the national Minister of Police in relation to the allocation of police resources in the Western Cape. Then, during his 2026 State of the Province Address in George, the Premier again announced that the Western Cape Government would "have no option" but to declare an intergovernmental dispute with the Minister of Police in relation to police resourcing in the Western Cape:

- (1) Whether the 2019 intergovernmental dispute was formally declared in terms of the Intergovernmental Relations Framework Act, 2005 (Act 13 of 2005); if not, why not; if so, (a) when did this happen, (b) did the Province follow the dispute resolution process provided for in the Act, (c) what was the formal outcome of the intergovernmental dispute instituted in 2019 against the national Minister of Police and (d) on what date was the dispute concluded;
- (2) whether any agreements were reached on police resourcing; if not,
- (3) whether the provincial government instituted judicial proceedings in terms of section 45 of the Act; if not, why not;
- (4) whether he has initiated a further intergovernmental dispute with the national Minister of Police since indicating such intention in the State of the Province Address; if not,
- (5) what are the reasons for the delay; if so,
- (6) (a) on what date was the dispute initiated, (b) how many other intergovernmental disputes has he initiated against the SAPS and (c) at what stage are each of these intergovernmental disputes;
- (7) given the declaration of an intergovernmental dispute in 2019, why is it necessary to declare a new intergovernmental dispute in 2026;
- (8) what changes to police resourcing, if any, were implemented by the SAPS between the 2019 intergovernmental dispute and the 2026 State of the Province Address?

- (2) (a) how many legal claims are currently pending against him, (b) of these, how many relate specifically to incidents arising from water-based school activities, (c) what is the total monetary value of these claims and (d) what portion relates to water-based activities;
- (3) whether the prohibition on water-based activities is applicable to all WCED schools; if not, (a) which categories of schools are exempt and (b) on what basis are exemptions determined;
- (4) (a) how many (i) schools and (ii) learners are affected by this decision, (b) what impact assessment, if any, has been conducted regarding the effect on learners’ water safety skills and (c) how does his Department intend to mitigate the loss of access to swimming and water safety education, particularly for learners in underserved communities?

- (3) (a) how many of these murder cases have resulted in suspects being (i) arrested and (ii) referred to court and (b) how many have resulted in successful convictions;
- (4) how many gang-related murder cases on the Cape Flats remain unsolved to date?

(a) How many members of the Anti-Gang Unit of the South African Police Service are currently deployed in the Western Cape, (b) of those members, how many (i) have previous criminal records, (ii) have pending criminal cases and (iii) are currently under internal disciplinary investigation, (c)(i) how many members of the Anti-Gang Unit deployed in the province have been criminally charged since the establishment of the unit, (ii) what was the nature of the offences in cases where members of the Anti-Gang Unit were charged with crimes, (iii) how many of them remain actively deployed in operational roles, (iv) how many of them have been suspended and (v) how many of them have been removed from the unit and (d) how many complaints regarding the conduct of members of the Anti-Gang Unit in the Western Cape have been investigated by the Independent Police Investigative Directorate?

- (3) (a) what strategies are in place to educate parents and caregivers about the importance of measles vaccination and (b) how does her Department collaborate with stakeholders to increase vaccination uptake;
- (4) (a) how many measles outbreaks have been recorded in the past three years and (b) what were the outcomes of her Department's interventions?

- (4) whether there are plans to expand this programme to additional communities in the province; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (2) in comparison to the 2025 school year, whether there are plans to expand the SRO Programme to additional schools in 2026; if so, (a) how many additional schools are being targeted and (b) what timeline has been set for such an expansion;
- (3) what partnerships exist between his Department and (a) the South African Police Service and (b) local law enforcements?
