1. Mr M G E Wiley moved: That the House debates the ability and responsibility of crime investigation in all the spheres of government and in the public domain.
2. Mr K E Magaxa moved: That the House debates the skewed shifting of focus of the Democratic Alliance towards the actions of sanitation protesters whilst ignoring the sanitation crisis in the Western Cape.
3. Mr J J Visser moved: That the House discusses the impact of the support of the Government of the Western Cape on the various municipalities in the province.

1. Mnr M G E Wiley stel voor: Dat die Huis debat voer oor die vermoë en verantwoordelikheid van misdaadondersoek in al die regeringsfere en in die openbare domein.
2. Mnr K E Magaxa stel voor: Dat die Huis debat voer oor die fokusverwringing deur die Demokratiese Alliansie deur te konsentreer op die optrede van diegene wat protes aanteken oor swak sanitasie terwyl die sanitasiekrisis in die Wes-Kaap deur die DA geïgnoreer word.
3. Mnr J J Visser stel voor: Dat die Huis die impak van die ondersteuning van die regering van die Wes-Kaap aan die provinsie se onderskeie munisipaliteite bespreek.
4. Me D Gopie stel voor: Dat die Huis die verhouding tussen die Wes-Kaapse Regering en bendeleiers bespreek.
5. Me B G Mbalo stel voor: Dat die Huis die onvermoë bespreek van die Provinsiale Regering van die Wes-Kaap om die vraagstukke aan te pak wat plaaswerkers raak en die gebrek aan vordering in dié verband.
6. Mnr P Uys stel voor: Dat die Huis die beperking op debatvoering in die Stad Kaapstad deur die Demokratiese Alliansie bespreek.

 - (3) me Combrink alle sterkte toewens namens die Wes-Kaap.

Mnr K E Magaxa stel voor: Dat die Huis die feit verwelkom dat die Direkteur van Openbare Vervolgings 'n aantyging gemaak deur die Minister van Gemeenskapsveiligheid van die Wes-Kaap, mnr Dan Plato, waarin hy beweer het dat senior lede van die African National Congress in kriminele bedrywighede betrokke is, afgewys het.

Me J Witbooi stel voor: Dat die Huis sy simpatie uitspreek teenoor die Minister van Kultuursake en Sport van die Wes-Kaap, dr Ivan Meyer, omdat hy die Demokratiese Alliansie se kandidaat vir die Premierskap van die Wes-Kaap gemaak is en derhalwe gedwing sal word om steeds in die skaduwee van Helen Zille, die leier van die DA, te beweeg.
