STATEMENTS BY MEMBERS

MOTION

Mr G Bosman: That the House notes that the Hon Rachel Windvogel, during the sitting of the House on 3 April 2025, made unfounded and inaccurate claims against Minister Ivan Meyer alleging that his visit to Taiwan constituted a betrayal of the country and posed a threat to trade relations with China; notes that the Hon Minister Meyer travelled to Taiwan in his personal capacity and did not engage in any formal discussions or represent the Western Cape Government during his private visit nor did he act in his capacity as a provincial leader; further notes the right of individuals, including public representatives, to travel freely without political interference; notes that the assertion in the House by the Hon Windvogel is a contravention of Rule 59; and resolves that the Hon Windvogel unreservedly apologises for deliberately misleading the House and withdraws her comments which negatively reflected on the integrity and dignity of a Member of the House.

Mnr G Bosman: Dat die Huis kennis neem dat agb Rachel Windvogel gedurende die Sitting van die Huis op 3 April 2025 ongegronde en onakkurate stellings teen Minister Ivan Meyer gemaak het wat beweer dat sy besoek aan Taiwan verraad teen die land uitmaak en 'n bedreiging ingehou het vir handelsverhoudings met China; kennis neem dat agb Minister Meyer in sy persoonlike kapasiteit na Taiwan gereis het en nie by enige formele besprekings betrokke was of die Wes-Kaapse Regering gedurende sy privaat besoek verteenwoordig het nie en ook nie in sy kapasiteit as provinsiale leier opgetree het nie; verder kennis neem van individue, insluitend openbare verteenwoordigers, se reg om vrylik sonder politieke inmenging te reis; kennis neem dat die bewering deur agb Windvogel in die Huis 'n oortreding van Reël 59 is; en 'n besluit neem dat agb Windvogel onvoorwaardelik verskoning vra dat sy die Huis doelbewus mislei het en haar aanmerkings terugtrek wat die integriteit en waardigheid van 'n Lid van die Huis in 'n swak lig gestel het.
