Consideration of the report of the Standing Committee on Social Development on its child protection multi-stakeholder's engagements held at the Western Cape Provincial Parliament (WCPP) on Friday, 27 June 2025, and Monday, 30 June 2025. 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FURTHER BUSINESS

NOTICES OF MOTION *(25 September 2025)*

1. Mr N P Masipa: That the House debates the extent to which the instability caused by dissolving the South African Tourism Board is affecting the Western Cape's tourism sector and whether greater devolution of tourism promotion is necessary to safeguard provincial economic growth.
2. Mr D W Bryant: That the House debates the rollout of the Western Cape Integrated Drought and Water Response Plan (WCIDWRP) and future threats to water security in the province.
3. Prof N Mbombo: That the House debates the integration of land transport in the Cape metropolitan area to reduce traffic congestion, drawing lessons from the N2 Express Joint Venture, and ultimately to create a sustainable land transport system across various modes, including the minibus taxi industry, e-hailing services, Metrorail, Golden Arrow Bus Services and the MyCiTi bus network.
4. Mr B M Ngqentsu: That the House debates the rising incidents of violence at schools.
5. Mr B M Ngqentsu: That the House debates the ongoing spate of mass shootings in the Western Cape.
6. Ms P Z Lekker: That the House debates the deepening water crisis in the Gate 7 Informal Settlement.
7. Ms P Z Lekker: That the House debates the failures of Cape Town's sewage and drainage system and its devastating impact on poor communities.
8. Ms B Stoffel: That the House debates the delayed implementation of the Traditional and Khoi-San Leadership Act.
9. Ms B Stoffel: That the House debates the lack of suitable land for traditional initiation practices in the Western Cape.

NOTICES OF MOTION *(18 September 2025)*

1. Mr M K Sayed: That the House welcomes the delivery of toilets to the residents of the Freedom Park Informal Settlement in Greyton, which falls under the Theewaterskloof Municipality, following the intervention of Sanco, the ANC in the Municipal Council and the ANC in this House; notes that the residents of Freedom Park had long been denied access to basic sanitation by the DA-led Theewaterskloof Municipality, forcing men, women and children to relieve themselves in bushes, in violation of their constitutional right to dignity; further notes that Freedom Park is situated on municipal-owned land, erf 595, which had previously been approved by the Municipal Council for the relocation of Madiba Park residents, but that the DA-led municipality had failed to implement this decision, leaving residents without security and basic services; commends the residents of Freedom Park for raising their voices sharply; resolves to call on the DA-led Theewaterskloof Municipality to go further by providing clean water, more toilets, and by ensuring the full implementation of the relocation plan to restore dignity to the residents of Freedom Park; and awaits the formal response of the South African Human Rights Commission following a complaint.

2. Mr M K Sayed: That the House notes with concern the events that transpired at Tuesday's meeting of the Standing Committee on Education, where the ANC informed the Chairperson, Honourable Peter Johnson, in advance that five members of the public had indicated their wish to pose questions or make brief input on school safety, the subject matter before the committee; notes that, despite this process being followed, the Chairperson, a DA Member of this legislature, denied the public the opportunity to participate, citing the Standing Rules, even though those rules do not explicitly prohibit public participation; notes that, by invoking Rule 82(4)(a), the Chairperson confirmed that it is ultimately at the discretion of the Chairperson whether to allow such participation in non-hearing meetings; further notes that this discretion has been applied inconsistently across standing committees, for example the Chairperson of the Standing Committee on the Premier and Constitutional Matters, Honourable Thomas Walters, has indicated that when Members engage with him in advance regarding the participation of the public, such requests would be considered and accommodated; notes that this demonstrates that other chairpersons, also DA Members, have been willing to facilitate participation, while others have taken the opposite approach; expresses concern that this inconsistency by DA chairpersons undermines fairness, transparency and predictability in the conduct of parliamentary business, and risks sending the message that public participation depends not on principle, but on the individual preference of the chairperson; further emphasises that relying solely on the Standing Rules, without due regard to the constitutional obligation in section 118 to facilitate public involvement, risks narrowing participation and stifling the voices of residents who seek to engage with this legislature; therefore calls on the Rules Committee to ensure that clear and consistent guidelines be developed and applied across all standing committees so that members of the public who follow due process are encouraged and enabled to participate, thereby strengthening accountability, accessibility and democracy in the Western Cape Provincial Parliament.
3. Mr M B Ngqentsu: That the House, employing a Marxist lens, notes that a municipality, which is effectively managed, cannot simultaneously have the highest rate of murders resulting from violent crimes and gang-related activities and have over 950 squatter camps where residents lack access to safe drinking water and adequate sanitation; further acknowledges that these conditions reflect a chronic crisis of underdevelopment, disproportionately affecting working-class and township communities; and moves that this House urgently prioritises and adopts measures aimed at addressing the deep-rooted structural inequalities and underdevelopment in these areas, in pursuit of genuine social and economic justice for all.
4. Ms A P Bans: That the House notes the findings of the United Nations Commission of Inquiry which concluded that Israel is responsible for committing genocide against the people of Gaza; further notes that these findings highlight the systematic killing of civilians, the destruction of infrastructure and the deliberate creation of unliveable conditions for the Palestinian people; expresses its solidarity with the people of Palestine in their struggle for freedom, dignity and justice; condemns in the strongest terms Israel's ongoing violations of international law and human rights; and calls on the international community, including the South African government, to intensify diplomatic, legal and political action to hold Israel accountable and to support efforts to end the genocide in Gaza.
5. Ms A P Bans: That the House notes the planned mass protest against the genocide in Gaza, convened by the Al-Quds Foundation South Africa, the Muslim Judicial Council and the

Palestinian Solidarity Campaign, in collaboration with civil society and faith-based organisations, to take place on Saturday 27 September 2025, from the Muir Street Mosque in District Six to the Parliament of the Republic of South Africa; acknowledges South Africa's moral and legal responsibility, shaped by its own struggle against apartheid, to take decisive action against Israel's violations of international law, including calls for divestment, the closure of the Israeli Embassy and the enactment of the Apartheid Bill; expresses solidarity with the people of Palestine in their struggle for justice and liberation; and commends the efforts of the South African civil society for mobilising one of the largest demonstrations for Palestine in the country's history.

6. Ms B Stoffel: That the House notes with concern the proposed sale by the City of Cape Town of public land, including the Camps Bay Library and adjacent parking, which has sparked strong opposition from ratepayers and community groups; further notes that the City claims these properties are not required for basic municipal services and seeks to optimise them for retail and commercial development, while promising to relocate the library nearby; expresses serious alarm at the lack of traffic, heritage, parking and community impact assessments, and at the absence of a clearly defined alternative site for the library; therefore calls for a comprehensive and transparent planning process, including full public participation for proper heritage, traffic and environmental studies; and calls for the City to preserve the character of the sensitive Camps Bay village by exploring alternatives to selling off public land.
7. Ms B Stoffel: That the House notes with deep concern that the DA-led Western Cape Government has placed the Knysna Municipality under administration in terms of section 139(1)(c) of the Constitution, dissolving the elected Council despite progress being made to stabilise service delivery; further notes that this drastic decision comes after years of governance instability, largely caused by the DA's political interference, which left the residents of Knysna facing chronic water shortages, sewage spills, waste management failures and environmental hazards; condemns the DA for using the plight of the Knysna residents as a political tool rather than working with the legitimately elected representatives to find sustainable solutions; expresses its solidarity with the people of Knysna who continue to suffer from the failures of the provincial government; and calls on the national government to intervene urgently to protect service delivery, restore stability and ensure that democracy and accountability are upheld in Knysna.
8. Ms B M van Minnen: That the House notes with grave concern the recent defunding of iconic cultural festivals and events, including the Cape Town International Jazz Festival, the Suidoosterfees and the Klein Karoo National Arts Festival (KKNK), as well as cuts to funding for various sporting associations; further notes the devastating impact that these cuts will have on local economies, job opportunities and the cultural fabric of our nation, particularly as communities continue to recover from the socio-economic effects of the COVID-19 pandemic; condemns the actions of the Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture who has shown disregard for the value of these internationally renowned cultural events that foster pride, identity, cultural exchange and employment opportunities for thousands of South Africans; acknowledges with concern the Minister's prioritisation of political gain over cultural and social well-being, including the redirection of funds towards headline events that boost his personal image rather than serving the needs of communities and the preservation of heritage; and calls on the Minister to reinstate immediately funding for

these critical arts, culture and sporting events and to end this “content-creator style” approach of governing by likes and comments that undermines the sector’s sustainability.

9. Mr G Bosman: That the House notes and welcomes the comments made by President Cyril Ramaphosa in which he acknowledged that the Auditor-General often reports that those municipalities that do the best are not ANC-controlled municipalities but are often DA-controlled municipalities; notes that the President encouraged public representatives to go and see what the DA-led local governments are doing; further notes that these comments reflect positively on the level of governance enjoyed by the majority of residents of the Western Cape as 22 of the 30 municipalities in the province are led by the Democratic Alliance; and further moves that, in line with the President’s encouragement to share best practices, the House debates examples of good governance in the Western Cape and, if the House so agrees that such a debate be led by the Leader of the Official Opposition who was present in the audience when the President made these comments.

VOORSTELLE MET KENNISGEWING (25 September 2025)

1. Mnr N P Masipa: Dat die Huis debatteer tot watter mate die onstabiliteit wat deur die ontbinding van die Suid-Afrikaanse Toerismeraad veroorsaak is, die Wes-Kaap se toerismesektor raak en of groter afwenteling van toerismebevordering nodig is om provinsiale ekonomiese groei te beskerm.
2. Mnr D W Bryant: Dat die Huis die bekendstelling van die Wes-Kaapse Geïntegreerde Droogte-en-waterreaksieplan (WKGDRP) en toekomstige bedreigings vir watersekerheid in die provinsie debatteer.
3. Prof N Mbombo: Dat die Huis die integrasie van padvervoer in die Kaapse metropolitaanse gebied debatteer om verkeersopeenhoping te verminder, met lesse geleer uit die N2 Express- gesamentlike onderneming, en om uiteindelik 'n volhoubare padvervoerstelsel met verskeie modusse te skep, insluitende die minibustaxibedryf, e-vervoerdienste, Metrorail, die Golden Arrow-busdienste en die MyCiTi-busnetwerk.
4. Mnr B M Ngqentsu: Dat die Huis die toenemende voorvalle van geweld by skole debatteer.
5. Mnr B M Ngqentsu: Dat die Huis die voortslepende vlag van massaskietvoorvalle in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.
6. Me P Z Lekker: Dat die Huis die groeiende waterkrisis by die Gate 7- informele nedersetting debatteer.
7. Me P Z Lekker: Dat die Huis die foute met Kaapstad se riool- en dreineringsstelsel en die verwoestende impak daarvan op arm gemeenskappe debatteer.
8. Me B Stoffel: Dat die Huis die vertraagde implementering van die Wet op Tradisionele en Khoi-San-leierskap debatteer.
9. Me B Stoffel: Dat die Huis die gebrek aan geskikte grond vir tradisionele inisiasiepraktyke in die Wes-Kaap debatteer.

VOORSTELLE MET KENNISGEWING (18 September 2025)

1. Mnr M K Sayed: Dat die Huis die lewering van toilette aan die inwoners van die Freedom Park- informele nedersetting in Greyton verwelkom, wat in die Theewaterskloof-munisipaliteit geleë is, ná ingryping deur Sanco, die ANC in die Munisipale Raad en die ANC in hierdie Huis; kennis neem dat die DA-beheerde Theewaterskloof-munisipaliteit die inwoners van Freedom Park vir 'n lang tyd toegang tot basiese sanitasie geweier het, en mans, vroue en kinders genoop het om in die bosse te ontlast, wat 'n skending van hul grondwetlike reg tot waardigheid is; verder kennis neem dat Freedom Park geleë is op munisipale grond, erf 595, wat voorheen deur die Munisipale Raad goedgekeur is vir die hervestiging van inwoners van Madiba Park, maar dat die DA-beheerde munisipaliteit nie hierdie besluit geïmplementeer het nie, wat inwoners sonder sekuriteit en basiese dienste gelaat het; die inwoners van Freedom Park aanprys omdat hulle hul stemme sterk verhef het; besluit om 'n beroep te doen op die DA-beheerde Theewaterskloof-munisipaliteit om selfs meer te doen deur skoon water en meer toilette te verskaf, en deur toe te sien dat die hervestigingsplan in geheel geïmplementeer word om die inwoners van Freedom Park se waardigheid te herstel; en op die amptelike reaksie van die Suid-Afrikaanse Menseregte-kommissie ná 'n klagte wag.

2. Mnr M K Sayed: Dat die Huis met kommer kennis neem van die voorvalle wat Dinsdag by die vergadering van die Staande Komitee oor Onderwys plaasgevind het, waar die ANC die Voorsitter, agbare Peter Johnson, vooraf ingelig het dat vyf lede van die publiek aangedui het dat hulle graag vrae wil vra of kort insette wil lewer oor skoolveiligheid, die onderwerp wat voor die komitee gedien het; kennis neem dat, ten spyte van hierdie proses wat gevolg is, die Voorsitter, 'n DA-lid van hierdie wetgewer, geweier het dat die publiek die geleentheid kry om deel te neem, en die Staande Reëls aangevoer het, alhoewel daardie reëls nie openbare deelname uitdruklik verbied nie; kennis neem dat, deur na Reël 82(4)(a) te verwys, die Voorsitter bevestig het dat dit uiteindelik na goeddunke van die Voorsitter is om sulke deelname aan vergaderings buiten verhoor toe te laat al dan nie; verder kennis neem dat hierdie goeddunke nie konsekwent by staande komitees toegepas word nie, byvoorbeeld, die Voorsitter van die Staande Komitee oor die Premier en Grondwetlike Aangeleenthede, agbare Thomas Walters, het aangedui dat, wanneer Lede vooraf met hom skakel met betrekking tot die deelname van die publiek, sulke versoeke oorweeg en tegemoetgekom sou word; kennis neem dat dit wys dat ander voorsitters, wat ook DA-lede is, bereid is om deelname te fasiliteer, terwyl ander die teenoorgestelde benadering inneem; kommer uitspreek dat hierdie inkonsekwentheid deur DA-voorsitters die regverdigheid, deursigtigheid en voorspelbaarheid van die uitvoering van parlementêre sake ondermyn, en die gevaar loop om die boodskap uit te stuur dat openbare deelname nie van beginsels afhang nie, maar van die voorsitter se individuele voorkeur; verder beklemtoon dat, om net op die Staande Reëls staat te maak sonder oorweging van die grondwetlike plig ingevolge artikel 118 om openbare deelname te fasiliteer, die gevaar bestaan om deelname te verklein en die stemme te onderdruk van inwoners wat met hierdie wetgewer wil skakel; dus 'n beroep op die Reëlskomitee doen om toe te sien dat duidelike en konsekwente riglyne ontwikkel word en by alle staande komitees toegepas word sodat lede van publiek wat die regte proses volg, aangemoedig en in staat gestel word om deel te neem, wat dus verantwoordingspligtigheid, toeganklikheid en demokrasie by die Wes-Kaapse Provinsiale Parlement versterk.
3. Mnr M B Ngqentsu: Dat die Huis deur 'n Marxistiese lens kyk en kennis neem dat 'n munisipaliteit, wat doeltreffend bestuur word, nie terselfdertyd die hoogste moordsyfer weens geweldsmisdaad en bendeverwante aktiwiteite en meer as 950 plakkerskampe kan hê nie waar inwoners nie toegang tot veilige drinkwater en voldoende sanitasie het nie; verder erkenning gee dat hierdie toestand 'n chroniese krisis met onderontwikkeling weer-spieël, wat werkersklas- en townshipgemeenskappe op 'n ongelyke wyse raak; en voorstel dat hierdie Huis dringend maatreëls prioritiseer en goedkeur wat daarop gemik is om aandag te skenk aan die diepgewortelde strukturele ongelykhede en onderontwikkeling in hierdie gebiede in die strewe na werklike maatskaplike en ekonomiese geregtigheid vir almal.
4. Me A P Bans: Dat die Huis kennis neem van die Verenigde Nasies se Kommissie van Onderzoek wat bevind het dat Israel verantwoordelik is vir volksmoord teen die mense van Gasa; verder kennis neem dat hierdie bevindings die sistematiese moorde op burgers, die verwoesting van infrastruktuur en die doelbewuste skepping van onleefbare toestande vir die Palestyne beklemtoon; eenstemmigheid met die Palestyne uitspreek in hul stryd om vryheid, waardigheid en geregtigheid; Israel se voortgesette skendings van die internasionale reg en menseregte ten sterkste veroordeel; en 'n beroep doen op die internasionale gemeenskap, insluitende die Suid-Afrikaanse regering, om diplomatieke, regs- en politieke

optrede te verskerp om Israel verantwoordbaar te hou en om pogings te ondersteun om die volksmoord in Gasa te beëindig.

5. Me A P Bans: Dat die Huis kennis neem van die beplande massaprotesoptog teen die volksmoord in Gasa, wat saamgeroep word deur die Al-Quds-stigting Suid-Afrika, die Moslem- juridiese raad en die Palestynse Solidariteitsveldtog, in samewerking met die burgerlike samelewing en geloofsgebaseerde organisasies, wat op Saterdag 27 September 2025 sal plaasvind, vanaf die Muirstraat-moskee in Distrik Ses na die Parlement van die Republiek van Suid-Afrika; erkenning gee aan Suid-Afrika se morele en wetlike verantwoordelikheid, wat deur sy eie stryd teen apartheid gevorm is, vir beslissende optrede teen Israel se skendings van die internasionale reg, insluitende beroepe om te onttrek, die sluiting van die Israeliese Ambassade en die verordening van die Apartheidswetsontwerp; eensgesindheid uitspreek met die Palestyne in hul stryd om geregtigheid en bevryding; en die pogings van die Suid-Afrikaanse burgerlike samelewing aanprys vir die mobilisering van een van die grootste protesoptredes vir Palestina in die land se geskiedenis.
6. Me B Stoffel: Dat die Huis met kommer kennis neem van die voorgestelde verkoop van openbare grond deur die Stad Kaapstad, insluitende die Kampsbaai-biblioteek en aangrensende parkering, wat sterk teenstand van belastingbetalers en gemeenskapsgroepe ontlok het; verder kennis neem dat die Stad beweer dat hierdie eiendomme nie nodig is vir basiese munisipale dienste nie en dit wil optimaliseer vir kleinhandels- en kommersiële ontwikkeling, terwyl hulle belowe om die biblioteek na 'n nabygeleë plek te skuif; ernstige kommer uitspreek oor die gebrek aan verkeers-, erfenis-, parkering- en gemeenskaps-impakassesserings, en oor die gebrek aan 'n duidelik omskrewe alternatiewe perseel vir die biblioteek; dus 'n beroep doen op 'n omvattende en deursigtige beplanningsproses, insluitende volledige openbare deelname vir behoorlike erfenis-, verkeers- en omgewingstudies; en 'n beroep doen op die Stad om die karakter van die sensitiewe Kampsbaai-dorpie te bewaar deur alternatiewe moontlikhede vir die verkoop van openbare grond te ondersoek.
7.
