QUESTION FOR WRITTEN REPLY

30. Mr M K Sayed to ask Mr D J Maynier, Minister of Education

With regard to the operations at Nduli Primary School in Ceres

- (a) (i) What is the current teacher-learner ratio in the school, (ii) including a breakdown per grade and (b) what is the state of the (i) library and (ii) toilets at the school;
- (2) whether the school has a special-needs classroom; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether his Department is currently constructing a new school in Nduli or surrounding areas; if not, why not; if so, (a) what are the relevant details and (b) which communities will this school accommodate?

Reply:

30. My department has informed me of the following:

- (1) (a) (i) The current teacher ratio is 1:39 (excluding Grade R)
 - (ii) The breakdown per grade (excluding Grade R and the Learners with Special Education Needs (LSEN) unit class) is as follows:

*There is currently no additional classroom accommodation to accommodate a third Grade 5 class. An application for an additional classroom has been submitted by the district and is currently under consideration. (b) (i) The school does not have a library.

(ii) The toilet facilities are in a functional condition and cleaned daily.

(2) The school has a LSEN Resource Class accommodating 6 learners.

Additional learners are being processed for admission from Term 3 onward. This class is taught by a qualified LSEN educator.

- (3) The construction of a new school in Nduli is not currently underway. Consideration for a new school in the area would be dependent on budget and land availability.
 - (a) The WCED is prioritising a review of the need for additional accommodation at Nduli Primary School.
 - (b) Once the review is completed, more details can be provided.
