**(b)(i)** See below table; **(ii)** Provide short-term (6-months) sheltered accommodation for homeless adults; Screenings, assessments and referrals; Social Work and social development services, such as: individual counselling, case work, group work, referral and support services. Development of individual client personal development plans; Skills development programmes, such as: gardening, recycling, job readiness initiatives; Education & awareness-raising programmes; Family reunification and reintegration services. **(iii)** Funding allocated for the 2025/26 financial year: R31 163 114.00 (See c for more details)

**(c)** - 024/25 financial year: R30 863 047.00

- 2023/24 financial year: R31 668 648.00

- 2022/23 financial year: R29 494 024.00

- 2021/22 financial year: R31 738 385.00

- 2020/21 financial year: R25 196 961.00

(d) The Department of Social Development (DSD) funds an average of 2,100 shelter bed spaces per year. These bed spaces can support up to 6,000 individuals annually, as beds are reoccupied by new clients once others exit the shelter system.
