8. Mr D J Wessels to ask Mr T A Simmers, Minister of Infrastructure:

With regard to property in the province that is owned by the national government:

How many land parcels, including the square kilometre per parcel, in the province are owned by the national government and is currently (a) in municipal use, (b) illegally occupied or (c) not in any use?

## **RESPONSE**:

- 8. (a) The National Department of Public Works and Infrastructure (NDPWI) is the Custodian of properties in the province that are owned by the national government (RSA). As the Western Cape Department of Infrastructure has no access to the Asset Register of the National Department, Information regarding the number of land parcels, including the square kilometre per parcel, should be directed to the NDPWI.
  - (b) For the same reason, Information regarding the illegal occupation of properties owned by the national government should be directed to the NDPWI.
  - (c) For the same reason, Information regarding properties not in use needs to be directed to the NDPWI.
