3.2.1 The utilisation of provincial sites and/or land to address the imbalances of the past in the province;

3.2.2 The refinement of Phases 1, 2 and 3 of the "Go George" bus service and a status report on the implementation of Phase 4; and

3.2.3 The Conradie Better Living Model Exemplar Project.
