- 3.1.1 An update on the video conferencing facility that is used to connect traffic law enforcement operational services, with specific reference to the number of occasions that this facility has been utilised, the cost thereof and evidence that this has in fact assisted with traffic law enforcement:
- 3.1.2 A report on the taxi operators and associations who violated the Code of Conduct for minibus taxi operators clearly outlining the type of offence, the name of the association or operator, the number of hearings that were held and the outcome of the respective hearing;
- 3.1.3 The cost to the Province of the Chapmans Peak Drive Public Private Partnership Project since its inception; and
- 3.1.4 A breakdown of the projected cost estimates for Transport Systems that were included in Sub-programme 4.4 over a period of three years for rail enforcement operations.

The Committee expressed its appreciation to the Department for their commitment to the work that they do.
