Report of the Standing Committee on Transport and Public Works on Vote 10: Transport and Public Works, in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 1-2017], dated 22 March 2017, as follows:

The Standing Committee on Transport and Public, having deliberated on the subject of Vote 10: Transport and Public Works, in the Schedule to the Western Cape Appropriation Bill [B 1-2017], referred to the Committee in terms of Standing Rule 187, reports that it supports the Vote.

In terms of Standing Rule 86, the African National Congress expressed its minority view that it rejects the Vote.

1. Information requested

- 1.1 The Committee REQUESTED that the Department provide it with:
- The minutes of the Property Portfolio Committee meeting where the decision was taken to 1.1.1 dispose of the Tafelberg site:
- The number of units to be erected and the intention of use of the four properties that 1.1.2 were identified to be transferred through the Department of Human Settlements to private sector developers for the construction of social housing;
- A progress report on the Office Modernisation Programme; 1.1.3
- 1.1.4 The size of the portion of the Woodstock Hospital Site that was made available to be transferred to the City of Cape Town and clarity if the transfer agreement will contain a conditional clause stipulating that the site must be used for social housing;
- The cost of the consultants that are involved with the six Central City Regeneration 1.1.5 Projects that will be put on hold pending the availability of funding; and
- An update on the road upgrade in the Baardskeerdersbos area. 1.1.6

2. Resolutions

The Committee RESOLVED that, based on the submission received from Ndifuna Ukwazi, it 2.1 will include the Tafelberg issue on its Committee Programme.
