

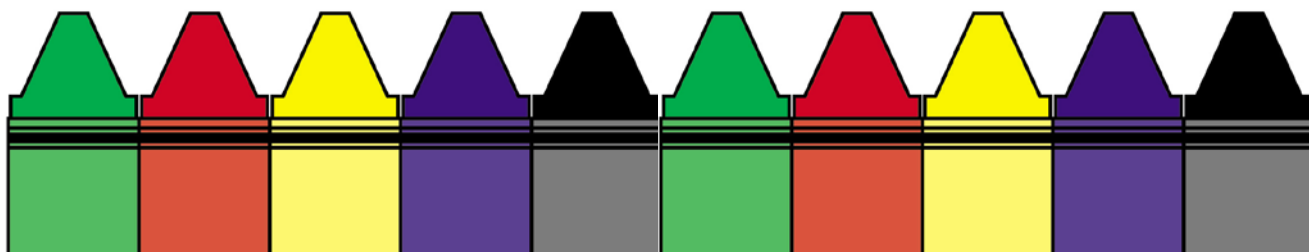
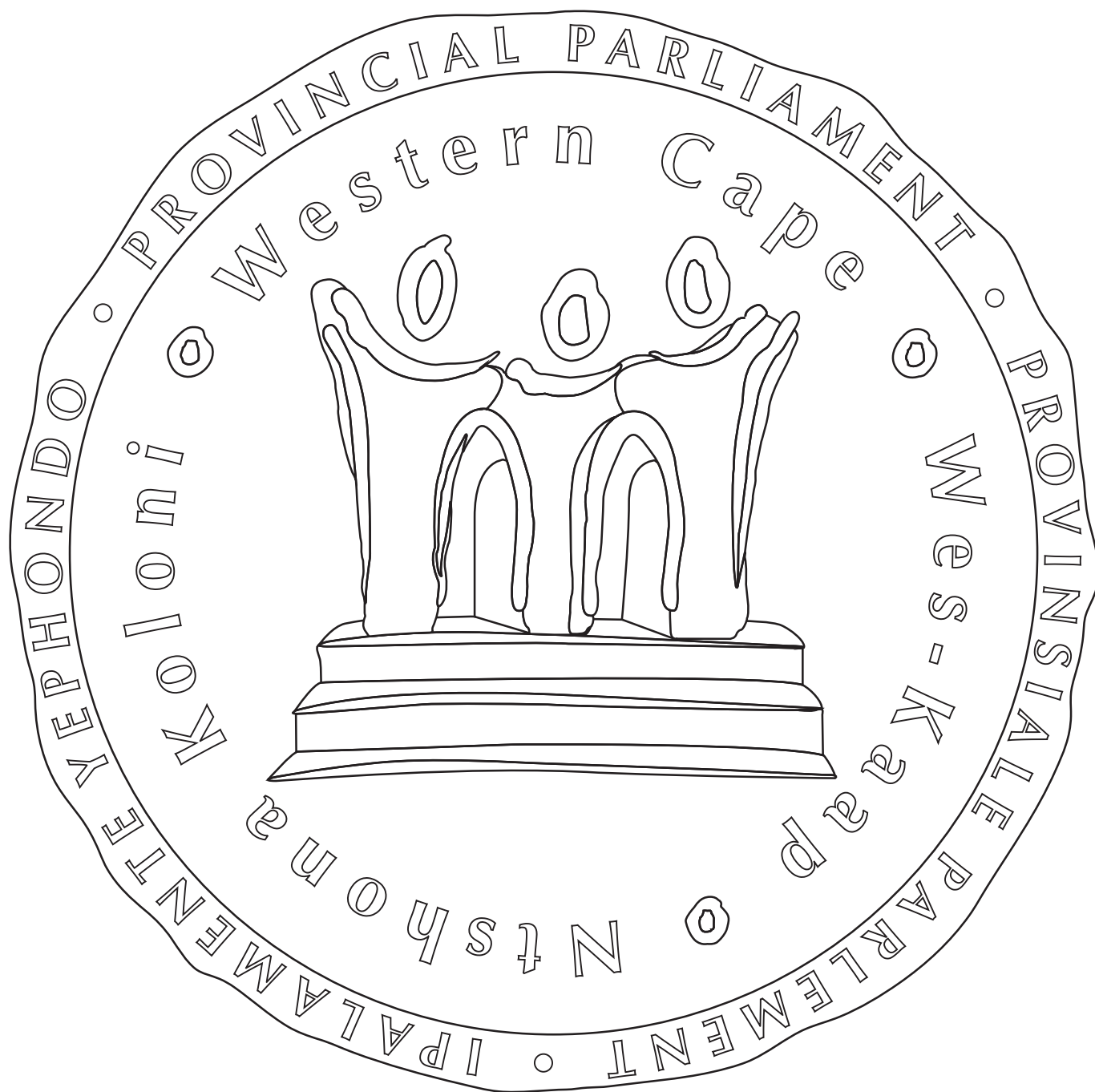

The Bill of Rights is contained in Chapter 2 of the Constitution and is the cornerstone of our democracy.

One of the main functions of Parliament is to pass laws.



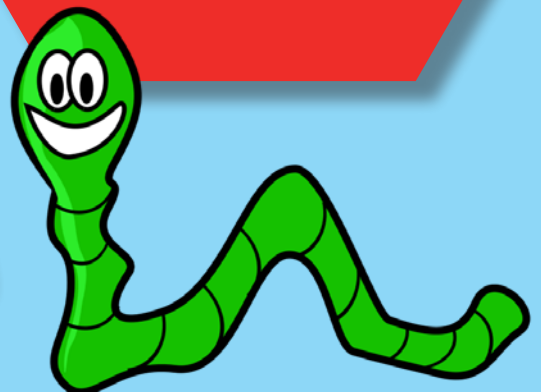
The word "Parliament" comes from the French word "parler" which means "to speak" and "parlement" which means a discussion.

The Constitution says there must be public access and public participation in the work of Parliament.



The mace, a symbol used in many parliaments across the world following the Westminster system, was originally a club-like weapon made of iron or steel. Presently, it is mainly used as a ceremonial staff-of-office and as a symbol of the Speaker's authority and the right of Members of Parliament to exercise freedom of speech.

The WCPP Logo depicts people at the centre of parliamentary business, with the three figurines representing not only the vibrant diversity of the Western Cape but also capturing the colours of the national flag.

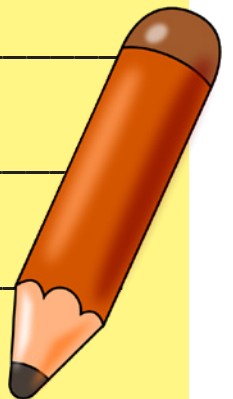


THE COAT OF ARMS OF THE WESTERN CAPE
