1. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr T A Simmers, Minister of Infrastructure:

With reference to the proposed wall being built along the N2:

- (1) What role is his Department playing in terms of (a) planning, (b) approving and (c) overseeing the wall;
- (2) whether a feasibility study has been conducted on the section of the wall that is under provincial jurisdiction; if not, why not; if so, what are the details of the study;
- (3) whether any money has already been spent on (a) planning, (b) design or (c) any other preliminary work for the provincial section of the wall; if so, how much?

2. Ms N D Nkondlo to ask Dr I H Meyer, Minister of Agriculture, Economic Development and Tourism:

With regard to the current drought in the province:

- (1) (a) What is the current state of the drought in the province and (b) what impact has it had on (i) agricultural production, (ii) food security, (iii) employment and (iv) farm sustainability;
- (2) whether his Department has (a) compiled or is in possession of a report detailing the state of the drought in each municipality in the province and (b) plans to mitigate the impact of the drought; if not, why not; if so, (i) what are the key findings per municipality and (ii) what mitigation measures are planned or currently being implemented and (c) can copies of the relevant reports and supporting documents be made available;
- (3) whether his Department has developed a plan to support emerging and informal farmers in municipalities affected by the drought; if not, why not; if so, (a) what are

the details of this plan, (b) which municipalities and categories of farmers are targeted and (c) what resources have been allocated for this purpose?

(2) whether his Department can provide details of the scope of work undertaken in respect of the housing upgrades; if not, why not; if so, (a) what specific aspects of the houses were upgraded, (b) what was the nature and extent of the improvements effected, (c) how many housing units were affected and (d) which contractors or service providers were appointed to carry out the work;

(3) whether, in the light of the fact that many of the current occupants have been renting these houses for a period exceeding 50 years, his Department has developed or is considering a plan to transfer ownership and to issue title deeds to the current occupants; if not, why not; if so, (a) what is the time frame for implementation, (b) which criteria will be applied to determine eligibility, (c) what administrative or legal processes must be finalised prior to transfer and (d) what steps has his Department taken to date to advance the transfer of ownership?

(2) what measures have been implemented to (a) mitigate the spread and (b) eliminate the disease, in the province;

- (3) (a) what protocols are currently in place to ensure that the affected farmers in the province can access foot-and-mouth disease vaccines and (b) how is vaccine availability being prioritised given national supply constraints;
- (4) what is the extent and nature of the cooperation between his Department, the national Department of Agriculture and municipalities;
- (5) whether there are any support mechanisms currently available to the affected farmers in the province to prevent business failure and job losses resulting from FMD-related restrictions and export impacts; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (2) with reference to section 45(2) of the National Health Act, 2003 (Act 61 of 2003), (a) what wording does the Department rely on to motivate lending public equipment and (b) how does this wording authorise the transfer or loan of state assets to private entities;
- (3) whether copies of any agreements entered into under section 45(2) between 2019 and 2025 can be provided; if so, (a) which of these agreements involve the lending of equipment and (b) what are the details of these agreements, including the (i) parties to the agreements, (ii) purpose and duration and (iii) obligations of each party?

- (5) what documented evidence was considered by her Department to confirm that public hospitals had surplus equipment capacity at the time when such equipment was lent to private entities?

- (4) whether approval for the Province to procure its own additional vaccine stock has been received; if so, how many additional doses are intended to be secured;
- (5) (a) how many animals have been tagged and registered as part of the vaccination and traceability programme and (b) what monitoring mechanisms are in place to ensure the ongoing surveillance of vaccinated herds;
- (6) (a) what assessment has been made of the potential economic risk avoided through the proactive vaccination campaign and (b) how will the intervention protect jobs and export-market confidence in the livestock sector?

- (3) (a) how much water was supplied by the Oudtshoorn Municipality to the Kannaland Municipality during this period and (b) what is the total (i) volume and (ii) cost involved;
- (4) what steps will his Department take to ensure stronger oversight of municipal compliance with water restrictions going forward?

- (3) whether there are any new desalination and alternative water infrastructure projects currently planned; if so, (a) what is their expected water-yielding capacity and (b) timeline;
- (4) beyond desalination, what other infrastructure interventions is his Department prioritising to strengthen the long-term water resilience of the province?

- (5) whether any additional funding has been allocated to address the backlog; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (3) whether any formal appeals have been lodged by beneficiaries in the province against Sassa decisions that resulted from the new process; if so, (a) how many appeals have been made, (b) what were the outcomes and (c) what is the time frame for resolutions?
