1. Mr F C Christians to ask Ms M M Wenger, Minister of Health and Wellness:

(a) What specific measures is her Department implementing to improve service delivery at provincial hospitals and (b) how will her Department ensure that patients receive timely and quality care across all regions of the province?

2. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr T A Simmers, Minister of Infrastructure:

With reference to the increasing demand for affordable housing in the Western Cape, particularly for well-located affordable housing:

- (1) (a) How is affordable housing defined in the context of the province and (b) what (i) legislative or (ii) policy instruments guide this definition of affordable housing;
- (2) whether a distinction is made between affordable housing, social housing, and gap housing; if so, what (a) definitions and (b) eligibility criteria apply to each category;
- (3) (a) what affordability benchmarks (for example percentage of household income spent on housing) are used to determine eligibility for affordable housing and (b) how were these benchmarks determined;
- (4) whether there is an affordable housing framework implemented in the province; (a) if not, (i) why not and (ii) when will one be implemented; (b) if so, (i) what are the key objectives and (ii) what initiatives fall under the framework?

3. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr D J Maynier, Minister of Education:

With reference to the written complaint sent to his Department by a certain person whose name has been furnished to his Department regarding the placement of her two sons and regarding the ongoing issues with school placements in the province:

- (1) Whether her two sons have been placed in schools suitable for their educational needs; if not, (a) why not and (b) when will they be placed; if so, where have they been placed;
- (2) given that this person received a response “made in fulfilment of the Department’s obligations towards your sons”, (a) what process does his Department follow when placing a child in a school, (b) what considerations, such as mental health needs, are taken into account when placing children in schools and (c) what factors determine the “fulfilment of the Department’s obligations”;
- (3) (a) what is the total school capacity in the province for each education phase and (b) what is the projected capacity demand for (i) 2026, (ii) 2027 and (iii) 2028 for each phase respectively;
- (4) which catchment areas in each school district were unable to accommodate the demand or applications in their district;
- (5) what options are available to learners who are not accommodated at schools within a reasonable distance of where they live;
- (6) how many learners have not been placed in schools for the 2026 school year as at the latest date for which information is available?

4. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr T A Simmers, Minister of Infrastructure:

With reference to his reply to question 1 of 16 May 2025:

- (1) Whether the reversionary clause will be triggered now that the deadline of 18 April 2026 has passed; if not, why not; if so,
- (2) whether the hall will be returned to the Western Cape Government; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether any (a) legal or (b) administrative steps have been initiated to enforce the reversionary clause; if not, why not; if so, what steps have been taken to date;
- (4) whether a formal notice of breach has been issued to the purchaser (Indoni); if not, why not; if so, on (a) what date and (b) what response was received;
- (5) whether the purchaser has made any representations to his Department explaining its failure to develop or use the property for the intended purpose; if so, what are the details;
- (6) what oversight mechanisms, if any, were in place to monitor compliance with the conditions of sale over the five-year period?

- (1) (a) Which 71 schools are affected and (b) what is the nature and extent of asbestos or other inappropriate materials present at each school;

- (2) whether each affected school has been subjected to a formal risk assessment; if so,
- (3) whether a plan is in place for each school; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (4) (a) which schools have been earmarked for (i) urgent intervention, (ii) remediation, or (iii) full replacement and (b) what are the (i) time frames and (ii) budgets attached to each planned intervention?

6. Ms R Windvogel to ask Ms M M Wenger, Minister of Health and Wellness:

In the light of the fire damage at the Railton Clinic in Swellendam and its subsequent closure for repairs, which has affected residents of Swellendam:

When is the clinic expected to reopen and resume full services?

- (1) What measures has his Department put in place to ensure that black farmers in the province are able to benefit from this zero-tariff scheme;
- (2) whether any (a) support programmes, (b) export facilitation initiatives or (c) partnerships are being implemented to assist emerging and small-scale black farmers to access the Chinese market; if so, what are the details;
- (3) how many black farmers or enterprises in the province are currently export-ready to take advantage of this opportunity?

With regard to the significant fuel price increases effective 6 May 2026, with petrol rising by R3,27 per litre and diesel by R6,19 per litre:

- (1) Whether her Department has plans or interventions in place to cushion vulnerable residents from the impact of these increases, particularly in relation to transport costs and food prices; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (2) whether any additional budgetary allocations or adjustments are being considered to support municipalities or public transport services in order to mitigate this impact; if so, what are the details?

- (2) (a) what is the breakdown of the top five destination markets for Western Cape citrus and (b) what is the assessment of the impact of the African Growth and Opportunity Act (AGOA) and current US tariff regimes on the Western Cape citrus sector, specifically addressing (i) the benefit of the November 2025 tariff exemption for oranges and (ii) the risk posed by the 30% tariff still applicable to mandarins (soft citrus), which are a primary export for the Western Cape?

- (2) what is the breakdown for the same period in (1) above of digital library usage, including (a) e-book loans, (b) Wi-Fi sessions and (c) public computer usage at public libraries?

- (2) whether all operational members are adequately equipped with the minimum required tools of trade; if not, (a) what is the shortfall per item and (b) what are the details of any supply chain challenges that have been experienced in the procurement of these items;
- (3) whether her Department has conducted any recent audit of the condition of operational equipment issued to SAPS members; if so, what were the findings?
