1. Mr B N Herron to ask Mr A W Bredell, Minister of Local Government, Environmental Affairs and Development Planning:

With reference to the research conducted on the proposed increase to the free water and electricity allocations for indigent households:

- (1) Whether the study will be released to the public; if so, when will it be released; if not, why not;
- (2) whether a copy can be made available to any Member; if not, why not;
- (3) what concrete steps is his Department taking to ensure that municipalities revise their indigent support policies in line with the updated research findings;
- (4) whether his Department has set any (a) timelines or (b) targets for municipalities to review their indigent allocations; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (5) according to his Department's data, how many indigent households in the province exhaust their free electricity allocation before month-end;
- (6) whether his Department has considered differentiated allocations for (a) larger households, (b) backyard dwellers or (c) multigenerational homes that consume more than what the current allocation allows; if so, what are the relevant details?

2. Mr B N Herron to ask Ms M M Wenger, Minister of Health and Wellness:

With reference to the Klipfontein Regional Hospital that was set to replace the decommissioned GF Jooste Hospital, and the ongoing delays this project has faced, and in the 2026 budget, funding is allocated to the "Metro West Hospital", previously called the Klipfontein Regional Hospital:

- (1) Whether the Metro West Hospital is the same project as the Klipfontein Regional Hospital; if not, where is or will the Metro West Hospital be located; if so, (a) why

is the site on which the GF Jooste Hospital was previously located not being used for the project and (b) where is the new site for the hospital located;

- (2) whether new land was acquired or bought for this relocation; if so, what was the cost of acquiring the land;
- (3) with regard to the approximately R4,3 billion that has been reported as allocated to the Klipfontein Regional Hospital Project, whether Budget Facility for Infrastructure (BFI) funding was formally approved for or allocated to the Klipfontein Regional Hospital Project; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (4) in the light of the significant delays in the project, what is the current status of the BFI allocation;
- (5) whether the allocation remains fully intact; if so, what conditions, if any, now apply to retaining or accessing the allocation in the light of the delays;
- (6) while smaller amounts appear to have been allocated for planning and preparatory work, what is the total amount of funding that has been spent on the project to date;
- (7) although funding was reportedly allocated to the Klipfontein Regional Hospital Project as early as 2019, it appears to have only been formally reflected in the national budget in 2026: why was there a delay between the initial allocation and its appearance in the national budget;
- (8) whether, at the time of the decommissioning of the GF Jooste Hospital, was funding already allocated or earmarked for the construction of the Klipfontein Regional Hospital; if so, (a) what amount was allocated and (b) in which financial year was this allocation made?

With reference to his reply to question 7 of 22 May 2025:

- (1) Whether his Department has received any formal response from the national Department of Human Settlements or the National Treasury following the lodging of the dispute; if so, what were the details of that response;
- (2) whether the intergovernmental dispute has been resolved; (a) if not, what further (i) engagements or (ii) processes are currently underway to resolve the matter; (b) if so, (i) when was it resolved and (ii) what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether his Department has escalated or intends to escalate the dispute beyond the current intergovernmental process; if so, what specific steps are being taken;
- (4) whether (a) mediation, (b) legal proceedings or (c) intervention through other intergovernmental mechanisms is being considered; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details?

4. Mr M K Sayed to ask Mr A R Winde, Premier:

With regard to the implementation of the Priority Queuing System for elderly persons in government departments:

- (1) Whether any provincial government departments currently implement the Priority Queuing System for elderly persons at service delivery points; (a) if not, why not; (b) if so, (i) which departments currently implement such a system and (ii) what measures are in place to ensure its effective functioning;

- (2) (a) which departments have recorded the successful implementation of the Priority Queuing System and (b) what best practices have contributed to its effectiveness;
- (3) what challenges or obstacles have been identified in the implementation of the Priority Queuing System across departments;
- (4) what interventions or recommendations are being considered by the provincial government to strengthen and standardise the implementation of the Priority Queuing System for elderly persons across all spheres of government service delivery?

5. Mr M K Sayed to ask Mr A W Bredell, Minister of Local Government, Environmental Affairs and Development Planning:

With reference to correspondence sent to his office on 17 November 2025 by the Helderberg Residents Concerned Group (HRCG) regarding a request to partner with the provincial government on the development of community facilities on provincial land situated between the Soet River Canal and Broadway Boulevard in Strand:

- (1) Whether his Department has provided any formal response to the HRCG since receipt of the correspondence in November 2025; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (2) whether his Department has considered the proposal for the establishment of educational, social, recreational and community development facilities on the identified parcel of land; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (3) whether any engagements, meetings or site assessments have taken place between his Department and representatives of the HRCG regarding the proposal; if so, what are the relevant details;
- (4) whether the identified parcel of land is currently earmarked for any provincial development, conservation or other strategic purpose; if so, what are the relevant details?

- (1) (a) What measures is his Department taking to protect residents, particularly poor and working-class households, from unlawful or excessive municipal tariff increases, (b) what engagement his Department has had with the City of Cape Town following the judgment regarding the financial and service delivery implications arising from the court ruling and (c) what oversight role did his Department exercise over the approval and implementation of the tariff structure adopted by the City of Cape Town prior to the court judgment;
- (2) whether concerns raised by residents, civil society organisations or ratepayer associations regarding the legality and affordability of the tariff structure were brought to his attention before the matter was taken to court; if so, what action was taken by his Department?

With reference to concerns raised regarding the proposed high-rise development in the historic core of the Cape Town CBD, including objections from heritage bodies and concerns about limited public awareness during the public participation process:

(a) What oversight role does his Department play in developments that may affect heritage sites, historic urban areas and culturally significant communities in the province and (b) what role does his Department, including Heritage Western Cape, play in ensuring meaningful public participation in developments affecting heritage sites, historic urban areas and culturally significant areas?

8. Ms P Z Lekker to ask Mr J J Londt, Minister of Social Development:

With reference to reports of prolonged electricity outages in parts of Delft (including Voorbrug, Leiden and Eindhoven), where residents have allegedly been without electricity for periods ranging from a week to more than a month, resulting in protests and severe hardship during the recent storms and cold weather:

- (1) (a) What emergency social relief interventions were implemented by his Department to support the affected households, particularly vulnerable groups such as the elderly, children and persons with disabilities, during the prolonged power outages, (b) what coordination took place between his Department, municipalities and other relevant stakeholders to ensure that the affected residents received adequate support and assistance during the service delivery crisis and (c) what measures are in place to ensure that vulnerable communities affected by the prolonged electricity outages, infrastructure failures or disaster-related disruptions receive timely social support and coordinated government assistance;
- (2) whether his Department has developed any contingency plans or community support strategies to respond to similar service delivery crises during severe weather conditions in the future; if so, what are the relevant details?

With reference to the recent outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease (FMD) in the province and its impact on livestock farmers:

- (1) Whether any disaster management or emergency relief funding has been allocated or requested by his Department in response to the outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease; if so, (a) how much funding has been allocated or requested and (b) from which source or sphere of government was the funding allocated or requested;
- (2) (a) what immediate support measures have been implemented to assist affected farmers, particularly emerging and small-scale farmers who have suffered livestock losses or economic hardship as a result of the outbreak and related containment measures and (b) what interventions are being implemented to assist affected farmers to recover economically and restore farming operations once containment measures are lifted?

10. Ms N D Nkondlo to ask Dr I H Meyer, Minister of Agriculture, Economic Development and Tourism:

With regard to the recent severe storm damage across the province of the Western Cape:

- (1) (a) What is the current extent of the storm-related damage in the province, (b) how many (i) households, (ii) informal dwellings (including shacks), (iii) public facilities and (iv) road infrastructure nodes have been affected and (c) in which municipal areas has the greatest concentration of damage been recorded;

- (2) (a) what is the total estimated financial value of the damage caused to (i) housing, (ii) roads, (iii) agricultural infrastructure and (iv) municipal services and (b)(i) how was this assessment conducted and (ii) by which authority;
- (3) whether the assessment has been independently verified; if so, what are the relevant details;

(a) What disaster relief funds have been allocated to the province and affected municipalities to restore damaged infrastructure, including informal settlement housing and road networks, (b) how much of these funds have already been disbursed and (c) what portion remains available for immediate and medium-term recovery?

- (2) (a) when was the last major upgrade undertaken on the sewerage infrastructure in Philippi and (b) what were the details of the upgrade;
- (3) in the previous three financial years, what percentage of the Human Settlements budget has been allocated to sewerage infrastructure upgrades in Philippi;
- (4) whether there are any plans to upgrade, repair or expand the stormwater infrastructure in Philippi to address general flood risks; if not, why not; if so, (a) what are the relevant details and (b) what are the timelines for the (i) implementation and (ii) completion of the planned stormwater infrastructure interventions in Philippi?

- (1) (a) What are the details of posts that have been advertised, (b) which posts have not been advertised, (c)(i) what is the longest period for which a vacancy has remained unfilled in each WCG department and (ii) why and (d)(i) which posts have experienced the longest delays in being filled per department and (ii) why;
- (2) (a) what is the total cost of employment (COE) budget allocated to each provincial department, (b) what is the expenditure breakdown of the COE per department, disaggregated per quarter, and (c) what are the reasons for any variances between the budgeted COE and the actual expenditure per quarter?

(a) What is the (i) number of ambulances allocated to each municipality and (ii) average response time per municipality for emergency medical services, (b) what measures are in place to address the shortages of ambulances or delays in response times in municipalities and (c) what are the safety measures put in place to protect paramedics?

16. Mr N B Nqgentsu to ask Ms A J D Marais, Minister of Police Oversight and Community Safety:

With regard to forensic pathology services in the province:

(1) (a) What is the total number of forensic pathologists currently employed in the province, (b) what is the current caseload per forensic pathologist, expressed as an average ratio of cases per practitioner, and (c) what are the prescribed standards and norms for workload allocation for forensic pathologists in provincial forensic services;

(2) (a) what is the current backlog of forensic pathology cases, including the exact number of cases in waiting;

(3) what is the average workload and caseload per forensic pathologist during periods of peak or seasonal high mortality in the province;

(4) what measures are being implemented to address staffing shortages and to reduce the backlog in forensic pathology services, particularly during periods of increased mortality demand?

With regard to the announcement by her Department that more than 800 new posts, including 316 nurses and 124 doctors, will be added as part of the 2026/27 health budget:

(a) At which hospitals, clinics or other health facilities will these health professionals be allocated or placed, (b) what is the timeline for the recruitment and appointment process and (c)(i) how many of these health professionals have already been appointed and placed as at the latest date for which information is available and (ii) at which facilities have they been placed?

19. Mr D W Bryant to ask Mr A W Bredell, Minister of Local Government, Environmental Affairs and Development Planning:

In the light of safety and security challenges, including muggings and criminal attacks, that have an impact on visitors in the open-access areas of the Table Mountain National Park (TMNP) footprint:

- (1) What is (a) the current status and (b) progress regarding the finalisation of the Heads of Agreement (HOA) between the City of Cape Town, SANParks and CapeNature aimed at coordinating management on the mountain;
- (2) (a) What (i) specific roles, (ii) operational mandates, (iii) enforcement responsibilities and (iv) property management agreements are expected to be performed by the agencies under current arrangements and (b) how will this address (i) safety concerns, (ii) streamlining joint law enforcement deployments and (iii) maximising monitoring capacity to combat crime across the mountain chain effectively?

- (2) what interventions has his Department implemented to resolve the (a) teething problems associated with the extended producer responsibility (EPR) regulations and (b) infrastructural challenges blocking local government partnerships with product responsibility organisations (PROs);
- (3) how many additional low-income households have been reached by (a) municipal S@S programmes, (b) swop shops or (c) buyback centres since the last report indicated that only five municipalities were operating in these areas?

- (1) (a) What is his Department's preliminary assessment of the total number of hectare of agricultural land damaged as a result of the weather and (b) what are the current departmental estimates regarding the total financial cost of the damage inflicted on agricultural infrastructure, including but not limited to (i) irrigation systems and pumping equipment, (ii) farm fencing, (iii) private access roads and bridges and (iv) riverbanks, riparian zones and sediment deposits in orchards and vineyards;
- (2) what is the (a) projected financial value of crop losses for the 2026 harvest season and (b) anticipated impact of these losses on the province's total agricultural export production volumes;
- (3) (a) what is the estimated number of agricultural jobs that have been disrupted as a result of the adverse weather and (b) what immediate mechanisms is his Department deploying to assist the affected producers?

(3) how many (a) private veterinarians and (b) producers in the province have registered to participate following the official gazetting on 4 May 2026 of the voluntary public-private Routine Vaccination Scheme for Foot-and-mouth Disease (RVS-FMD) under section 10 of the Animal Diseases Act, 1984 (Act 35 of 1984)?
